Strategic Review : WHY ?

- significant reduction in drugs funding over the next 3 years
- to rationalise current commissioning arrangements
- provide a robust commissioning strategy for both drugs and alcohol

Strategic Review : Aim

To have in place, by 1st April 2010, the best possible configuration of properly contracted and monitored drug and alcohol services, which meet identified needs and targets and are affordable within the available budget

Strategic Review : How ?

A three stage process :

- Stage 1 - Strategic Review Information Pack (SRIP)
- Stage 2 - Formal Consultation leading to Development Plan
- Stage 3 - Implementation Plan leading to operational service delivery

Stage 1 : Information

The SRIP

- an analysis of drug and alcohol services delivered in Hampshire, to provide a baseline position for the review
- verified and enhanced by stakeholders, users and carers.

The SRIP : Content

- Strategic Context
- Indicators and Targets
- Demographics
- Client Group Information
- Current Treatment System
- Financial Information
- Services and Capacity
- Performance and Current Activity
- Challenges and Constraints

Stage 2 : Development

- formal consultation with stakeholders, users and carers in order to develop proposals for the future which best meet evidenced need and budget constraints
- culminates in the production of a Development Plan or commissioning strategy to shape future provision

Stage 3 : Implementation

- service level Implementation Plan to 'operationalise' the commissioning intentions set out in the Development Plan
- may involve reconfiguration and services may be commissioned, de-commissioned or remodeled

Timetable

- Stage 1 - Information - Jul to Sep 2008
- Stage 2 - Development - Oct to Dec 2008
- Stage 3 – Implementation – Jan 2009 to Mar 2010
