Michael Austin Harlick

Memorial Fund Trophy Grants are provided from the Michael Austin Harlick Memorial Fund, which is administered by Hampshire County Council.

Michael Austin Harlick lived in Gosport. He was badly injured whilst a prisoner of war in World War II and devoted much of his later life to supporting school sport in Hampshire. He left his entire estate to Hampshire County Council to provide awards which would reward and support the sporting achievements of Hampshire's young people.

What is a Trophy Grant?

Trophy grants provide financial assistance to sports organisations towards the cost of awards that recognise the sporting achievements of young people in Hampshire. Grants are available to help with the purchase of:

- Challenge cups
- Medals
- Team awards and colours

Application forms are separately available for **special awards** to assist individuals experiencing extreme financial hardship.

Who can apply?

Applications for Trophy grants are welcome from organisations providing sporting opportunities for school-aged people in Hampshire.

These will include:

- County and District Junior Sports Associations
- County and District Schools Sports Associations
- Cluster groups of schools
- Groups working with young people with disabilities
- Clubs hosting "open" tournaments
(Enclosing a programme or entry form with this application will aid your bid.)

Applications for club trophies will not be considered

The Michael Austin Harlick Memorial Fund has produced a **Certificate of Sporting Achievement**. Copies are available to associations in small quantities (no more than 100).

How much is a Trophy Grant?

Normally approved grants will be 50% of the total cost (excluding VAT). The size of the grant may vary, according to the total fund available and the financial stability of the applying organisation.

How to apply for a Trophy Grant

- Send a completed application form with a quotation for the total cost of the trophies to the address below
- Enclose a statement of the organisation's recent accounts

What happens next?

You will be informed by letter if you have been successful and, if so, please follow this procedure:

- Ask for the invoice to be made out to the Michael Austin Harlick Trust c/o your name and address
- On receipt of the goods, pay the invoice in full
- Send original invoice and receipt (as proof of payment) to the address below

Once proof of payment is received, a cheque for the grant will be sent.

Associations will have one year after receiving the letter in which to claim the grant.
