

The Campbell Road and Chalvington area 44 Carshare

A public transport service for passengers travelling from Campbell Road and the Chalvington Road area into Eastleigh town centre

What is the Campbell Road and Chalvington area 44 Carshare?

It is a public transport service for anyone who needs to travel from Campbell Road or roads around Chalvington Road into Eastleigh town centre.

The service is similar to a bus service, except that passengers will need to book in advance and the journey will be operated by a 'taxi' instead of a bus.

Where can I travel to?

You can be dropped off/picked up at:

- The Swan Centre
- Newtown Road Health Centre
- Eastleigh Bus Station
- Eastleigh Railway Station

Where will I be picked up from?

The taxi will pick you up from your home address.

What do I do next?

Firstly you must register with Hampshire County Council (this is free) by calling the number below.

You will then be sent a membership pack with the booking number to ring when you would like to travel.

How do I use it?

To use the service you must book your seat by 4pm the day before you wish to travel.

You can book as far in advance as you like.

How much will it cost?

	Single	Return
Campbell Road/Chalvington to Eastleigh	£1.80	£3.00

If you have a Concessionary Travel Bus Pass you may use it on this Taxishare service in accordance with the rules of the scheme.

Children between 5 and 16 years of age may travel for half price and those under 5 may travel free.


