# Alien Family part 1

This project can be made in conjunction with the **Alien Spacecraft** project.

## You will need:

9 x pom-poms:  
3 very large and 6 small  
(catalogue no. 209314)

Coloured felt pieces  
(catalogue no. 209637  
or 209338)

Glue (e.g. Power Pritt Gel,  
catalogue no. 701702)

## For Mum, Dad and Young Alien:

- 1 Begin by selecting 3 very large pom-poms to make each alien's body.
- 2 Cut three sets of alien feet from felt (or you could use card if you prefer). See *diagram 1*.
- 3 Using glue, attach each pair of feet to a pom-pom body.
- 4 Glue two small pom-poms onto the body to give each alien a pair of eyes.
- 5 To create the mouths of the Dad and Young aliens, cut a 'leaf' shape from a piece of felt. Cut the 'leaf' in half lengthways.
- 6 To create the mouth of the Mum alien, cut a 'pair of lips' shape from a piece of felt. Cut the lips in half lengthways. See *diagram 2*.
- 7 Cut out three sets of teeth from a piece of white felt – one for each alien. See *diagram 3*.
- 8 Glue a bottom lip to each alien, making sure the straight edge is at the top.
- 9 Now glue the teeth to the bottom lip, lining up the straight edge of the teeth with the straight edge of the lip.
- 10 Glue the top lips to each alien. Remember that the Dad and Young aliens should have the leaf-shaped top lips. See *diagram 4*.
- 11 Your Dad and Young aliens are now complete! To finish the Mum alien, cut six strips from black felt. Glue the strips behind the alien's eyes to create fluttering eyelashes! See *diagram 5*.

# Alien Family part 2

This project can be made in conjunction with the **Alien Spacecraft** project.

## You will need:

4 x pom-poms: 1 large, 1 medium-sized and 2 very small (catalogue no. 209314)

Coloured felt pieces (catalogue no. 209637 or 209338)

Glue (e.g. Power Pritt Gel, catalogue no. 701702)

Black pen or felt tip

## For the Space Pet

- 1 Begin by selecting a medium-sized pom-pom and a large pom-pom to make the pet's body.
- 2 Glue the two pom-poms together. See *diagram 1*.
- 3 Cut out the pet's feet from a piece of yellow felt or card. See *diagram 2*. Glue the feet to the larger of the two pom-poms comprising the pet's body.
- 4 Using glue, stick two very small white pom-poms onto the smaller of the two pom-poms comprising the pet's body to create eyes. See *diagram 3*.
- 5 Draw a black dot in the middle of each eye.
- 6 Cut a triangle from a piece of yellow felt or card. Apply glue to the edge of the felt and stick beneath the pet's eyes so that the point of the triangle faces outwards. This is the pet's beak.
- 7 Cut a tail shape from a piece of felt. See *diagram 4*. If you prefer, you could use a piece of coloured feather (catalogue no. 209302).
- 8 Your space pet is now complete and ready to join its alien family! However, you can continue to decorate the space pet with coloured felt or feathers. We gave our space pet a line of bright pink felt diamonds along its back (see *photograph*) – but it is entirely up to you!

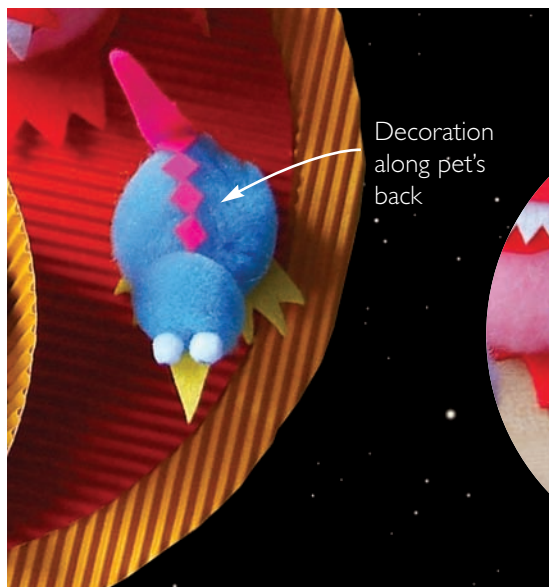

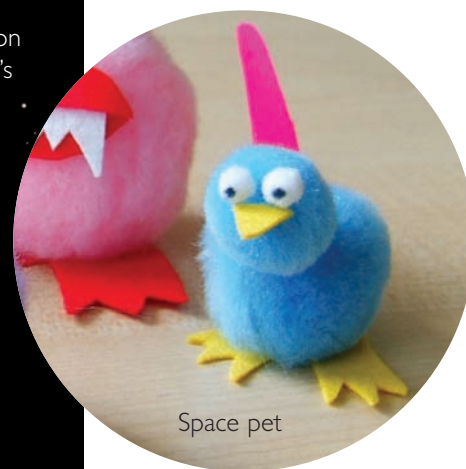
