

Step-by-step guide to making a...

Batty Bat pen topper.

1

You will need:

2 x very small yellow pom-poms,
2 x small brown pom-poms and
1 x medium black pom-pom
(catalogue no. 209314)

Piece of black felt
(catalogue no. 209637
or 209338)

1 x pipecleaner
(catalogue no. 204151
or 204450)

Glue (e.g. Power Pritt Gel,
catalogue no. 701702)

Black pen or felt tip

1 Begin by winding a pipecleaner around a pen or pencil to form a spring. Leave about 2cm at the top and coil the pipecleaner back on itself. This will form a base on which to glue your design.

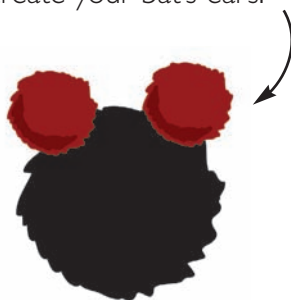


2 Cut out your bat's wings from black felt as shown:



3 Apply a drop of glue to the top of the pipecleaner spring (at the point where you coiled the last 2cm back to create a base) and attach the wings to the pipecleaner.

4 Glue two small brown pom-poms to a medium-sized black pom-pom to create your bat's ears.



5 Glue two very small yellow pom-poms to the black pom-pom to create eyes. Draw a black dot in the middle of each eye.

6 Using glue, attach the finished bat body to the wings as shown in the photograph. Allow to dry.

7 Thread the pen topper onto your favourite pen or pencil!
