

**You will need:**

2 x pipecleaners in black and yellow  
(cat no. 204153)

2 x wiggly eyes (cat no. 209997)

Piece of tracing paper  
(cat no. 817203)

Glue (eg. cat no. 701702)

**How to make your Bumblebee:**

1. Begin by winding a length of black pipecleaner around a pencil. Make sure that you leave a gap between the coils about the width of the pipecleaner.
2. Take a yellow pipecleaner and wind it around the pencil, filling in the gaps between the black coils.
3. Remove the pencil and carefully tuck the ends of the pipecleaner in. Add a dab of glue at each end to secure the pipecleaners in place.
4. Next, gently push all the coils up together so that you end up with something that resembles a black and yellow humbug.
5. Choose an end of the 'humbug' to be the bumblebee's face. Using glue, attach two wiggly eyes.
6. To make the wings, cut out a small 'heart shape' from a piece of tracing paper. Put a dab of glue at the point of the heart shape and tuck it into the top of the bumblebee, between the pipecleaners. Allow to dry.
7. Finish the bumblebee by using it to adorn your Festival of Flowers creations or floral Mother's Day cards.
