The service offers evidence based clinical interventions centred around education about psychosis, alongside pharmacological, psychological, social and family based interventions. The service also aims to increase the knowledge about early signs of psychosis for staff working in primary care, schools and all public and voluntary sectors who may come into contact with individuals who may be at risk of first episodes. Ages 14-35 years.
