Note:

This version of the booklet has been produced for audiences external to Hampshire County Council.

The difference between internal and external versions is where small numbers are concerned. To prevent the identification of individuals, wherever a cohort contains 5 or fewer pupils the cohort size is shown simply as <5, and the corresponding percentage of total is blanked out. In instances where there is only one ethnic group with fewer than 5 people, the exact number in the next smallest group is also hidden. Wherever showing cohort size as <5 is not sufficient to protect identities, small cohort sizes show as <10.

Summary

There are currently 2,087 ethnic minority children and young people (C&YP) at schools within Rushmoor, which represents 19.8% of the district (19.2% last year)

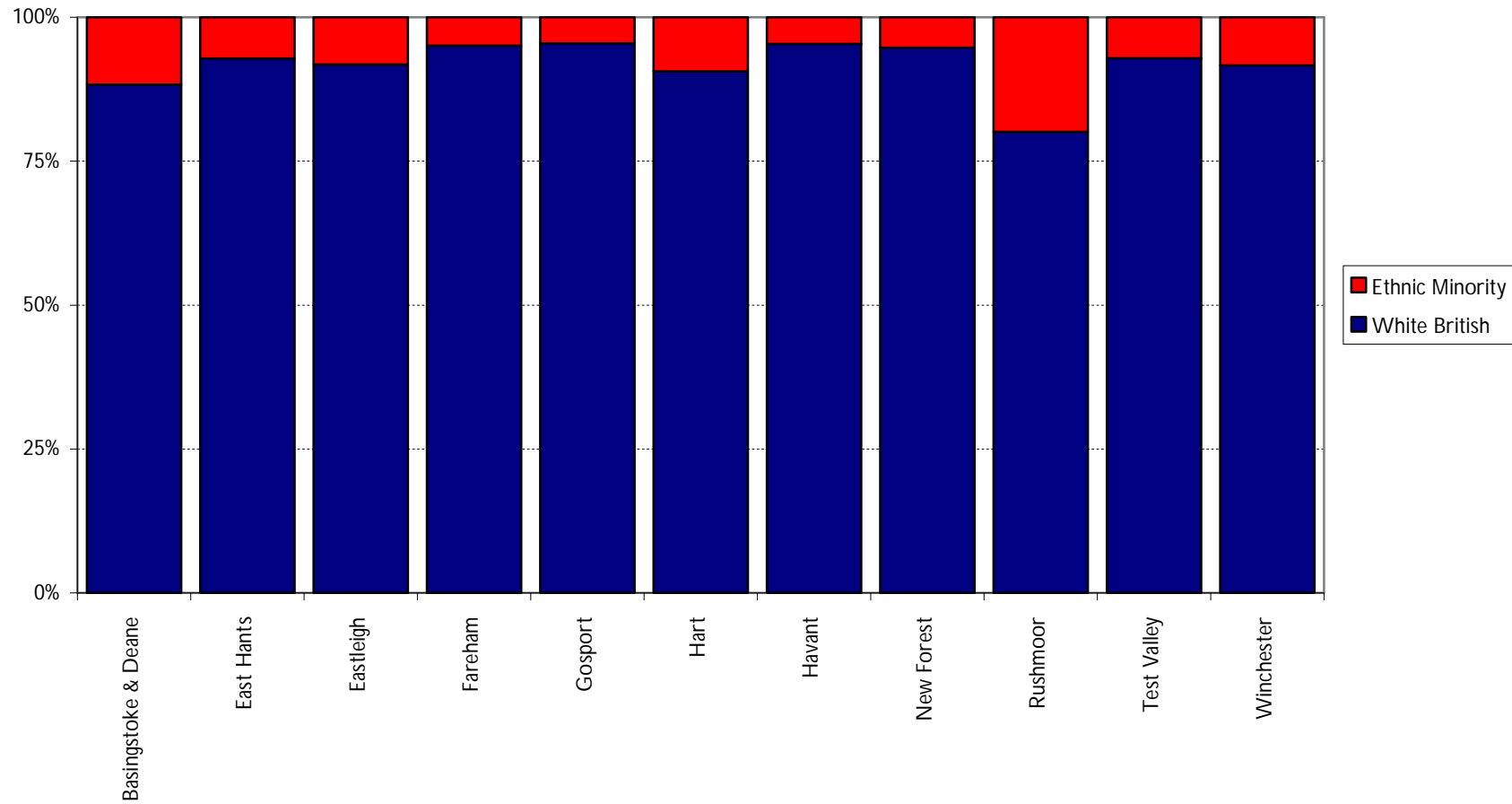
Ethnic minority C&YP from Rushmoor schools account for 15.3% of the overall total for the county.

There are currently 71 different languages spoken by C&YP within the district, up from 67 last year.

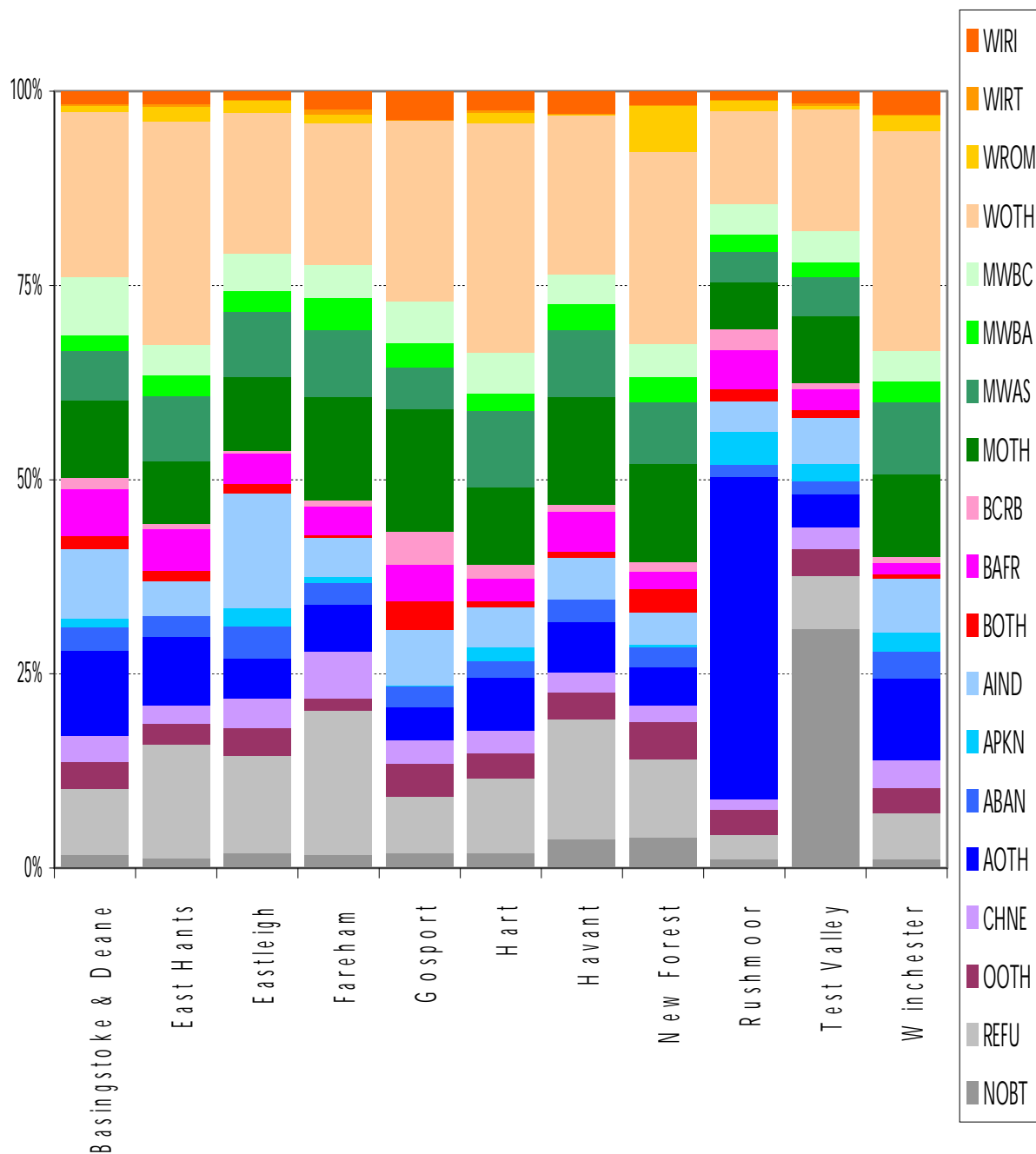
13.7% of the pupils have English as an additional language (13.3% last year).

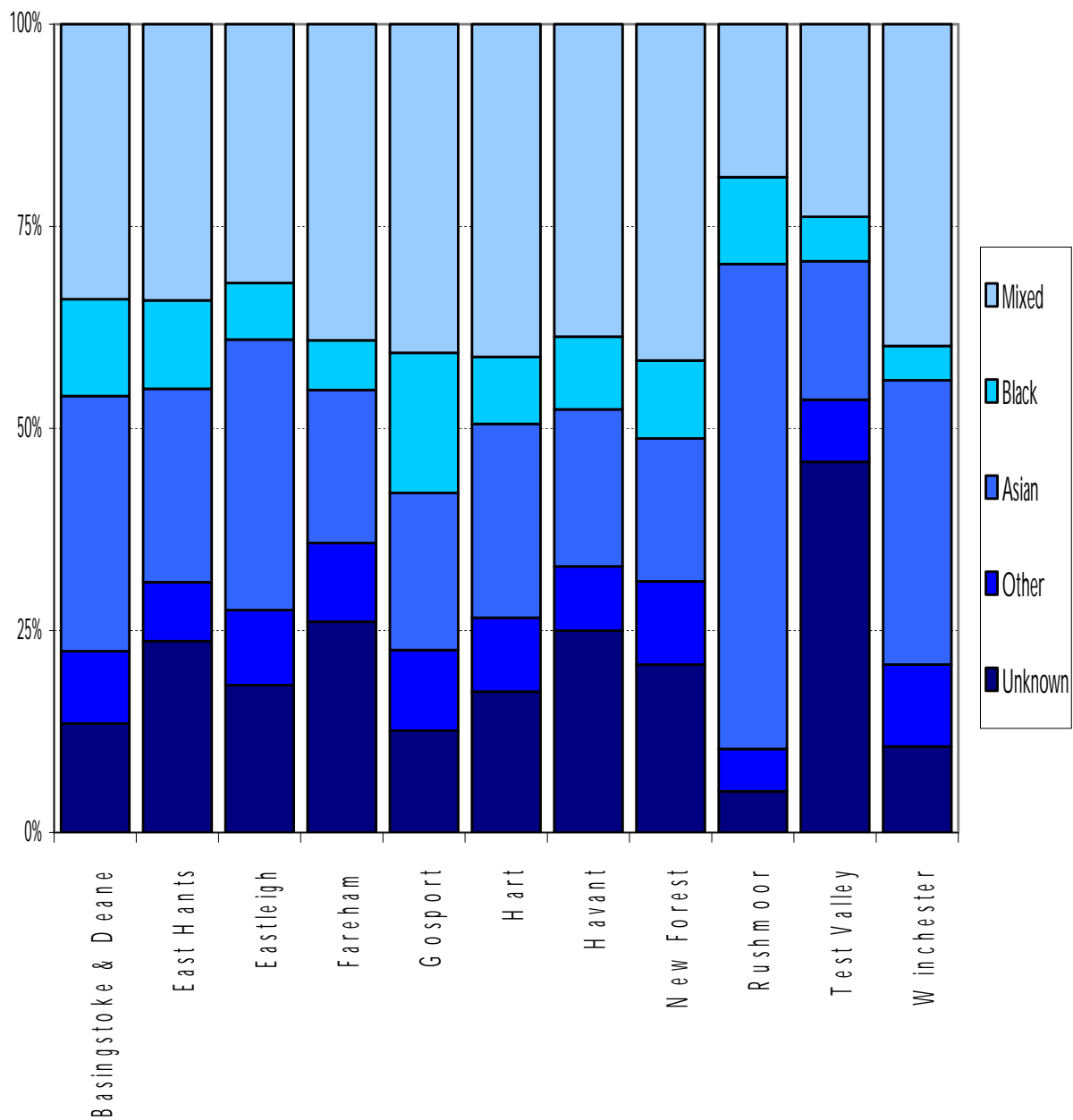
Ethnic Minority Pupils at Hampshire state-maintained schools, split by school district

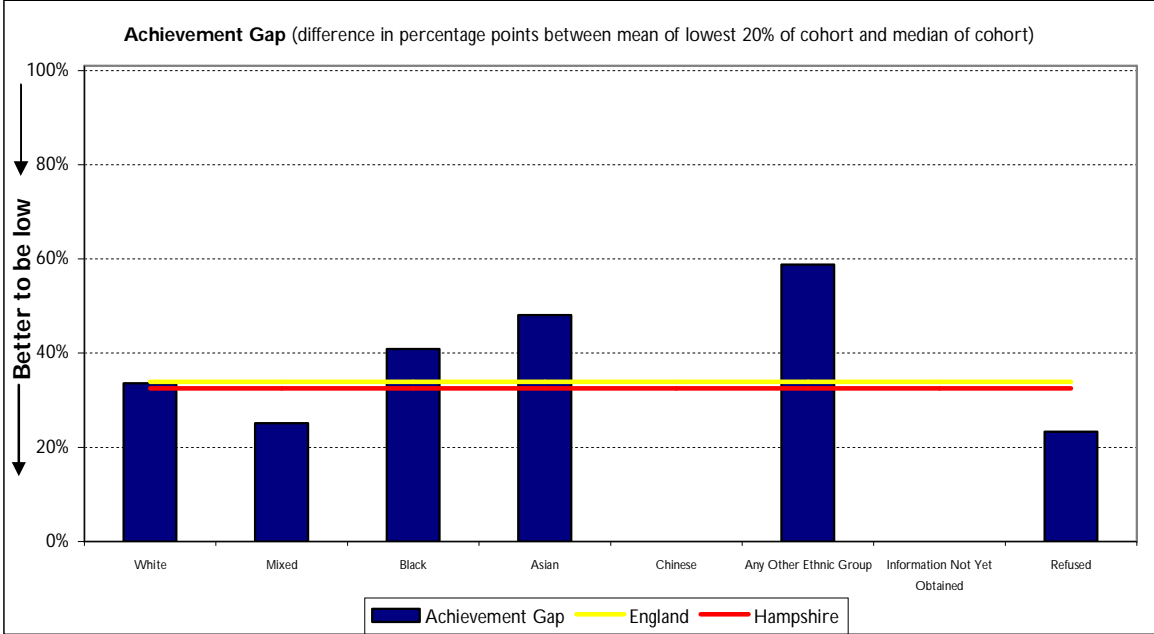

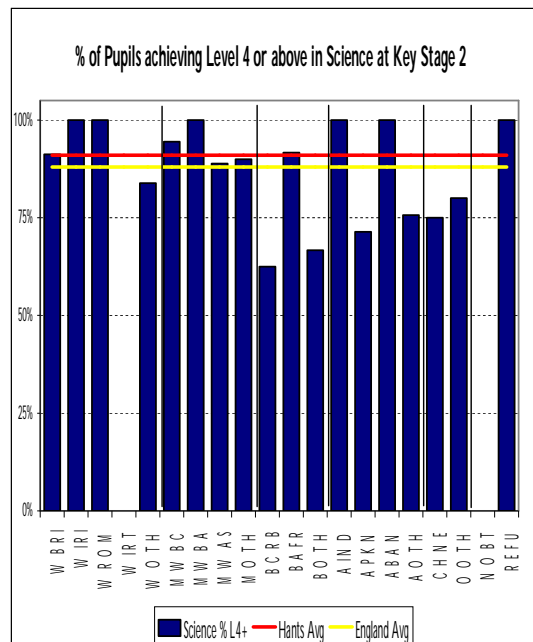
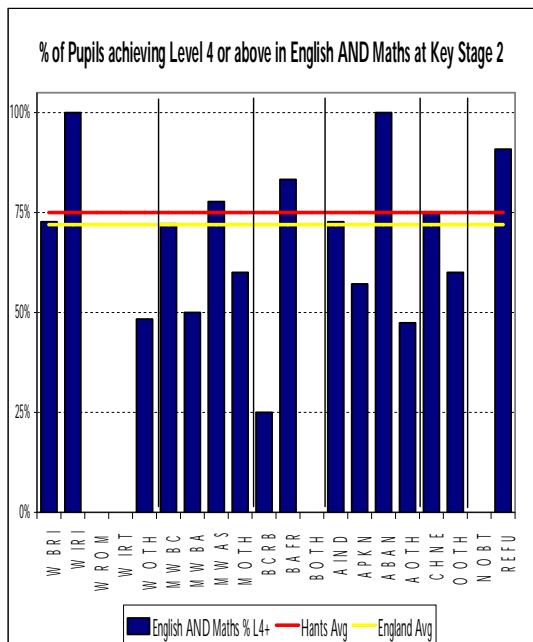
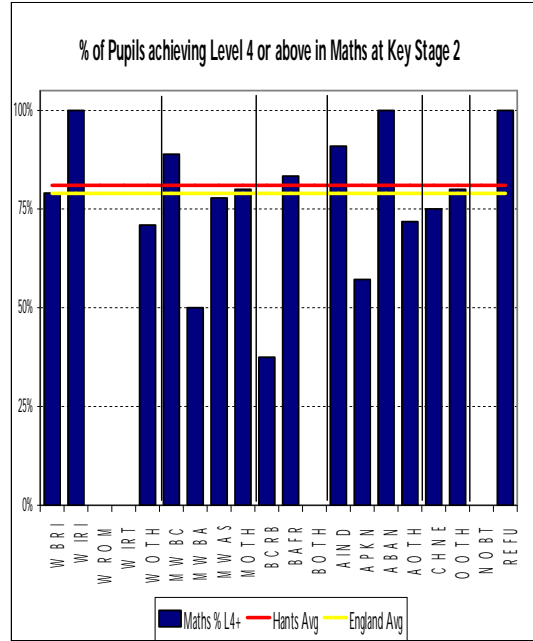
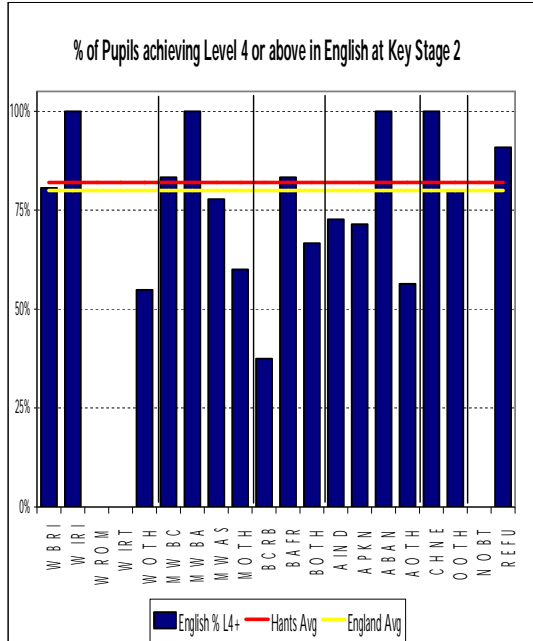
Key Stage 1 attainment charts

District-level: Rushmoor



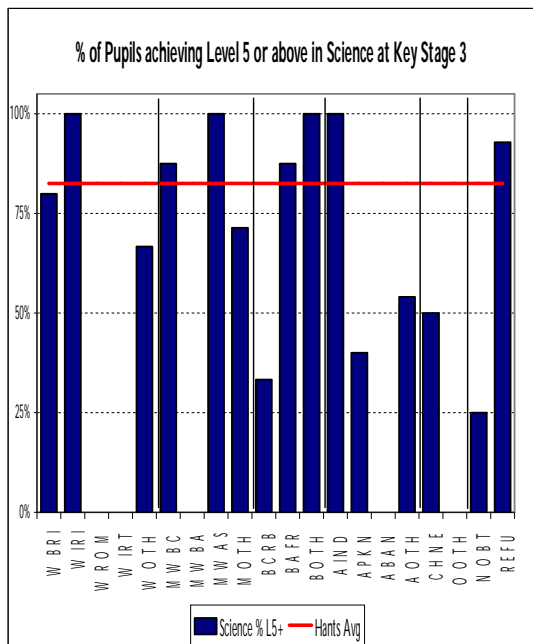
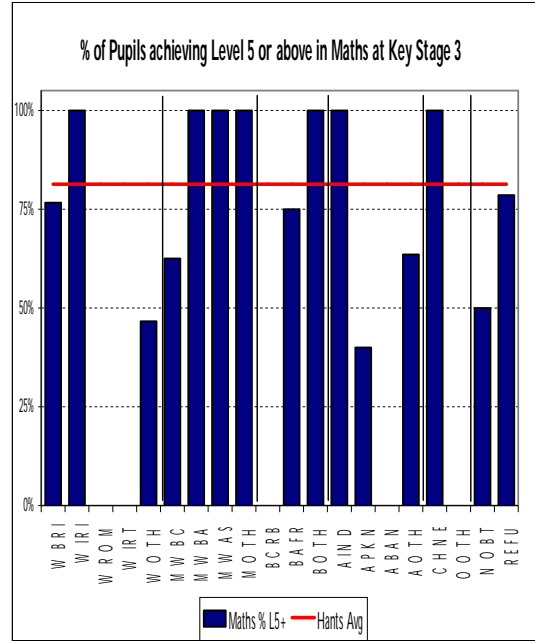
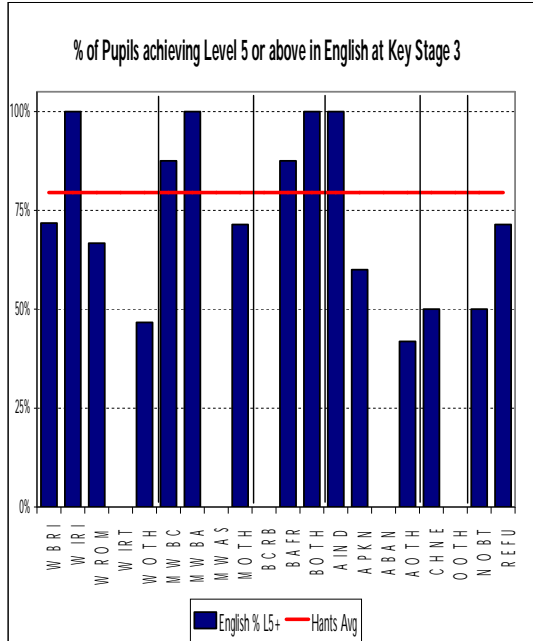
Key Stage 2 attainment charts

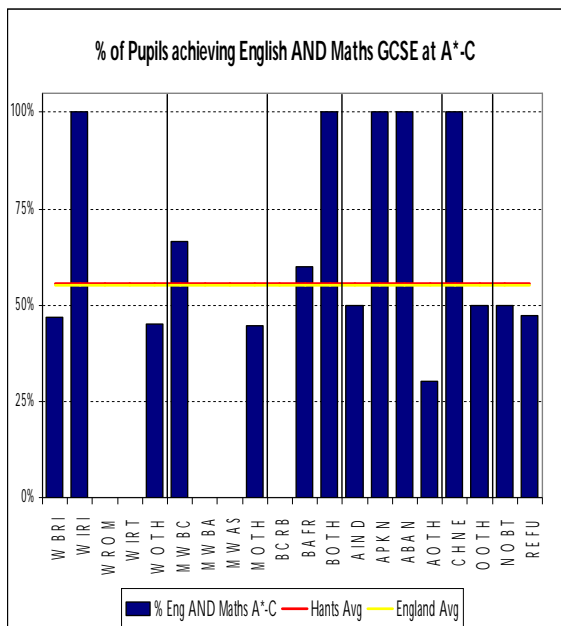
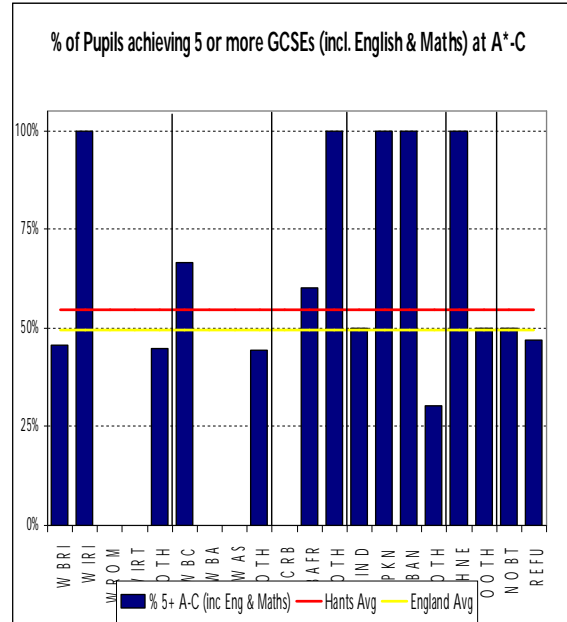
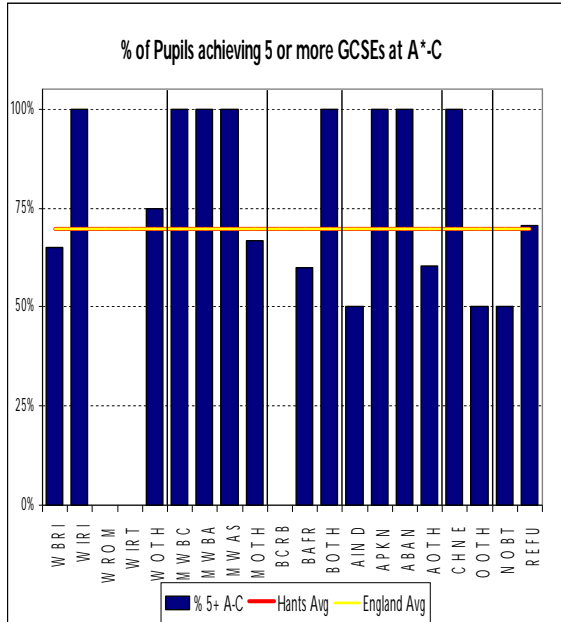
Key Stage 3 attainment charts

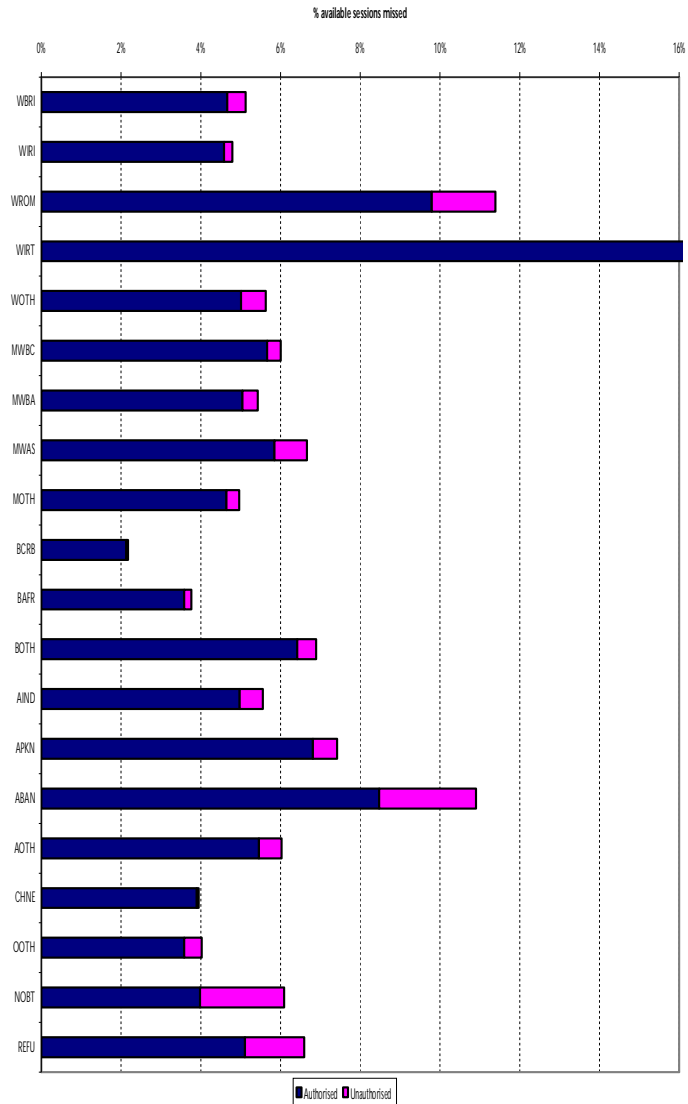
2009 Narrowing The Attainment Gap – county level

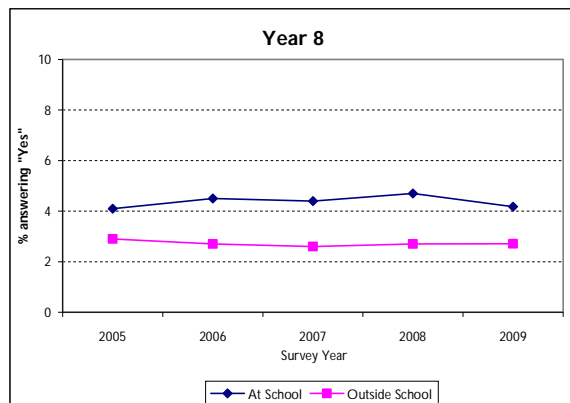
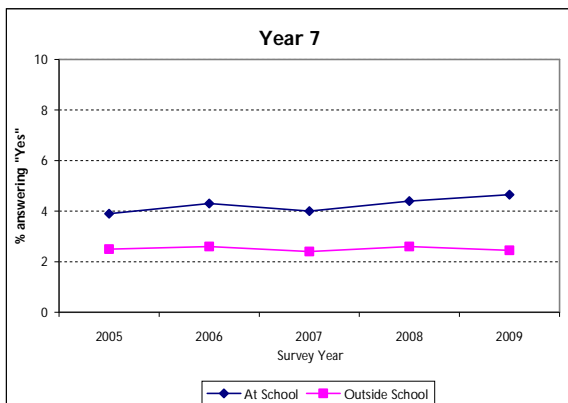
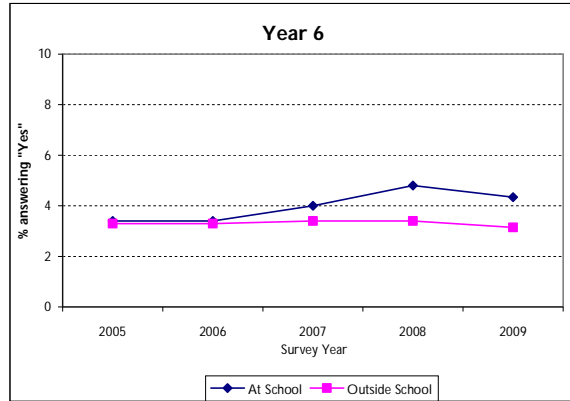
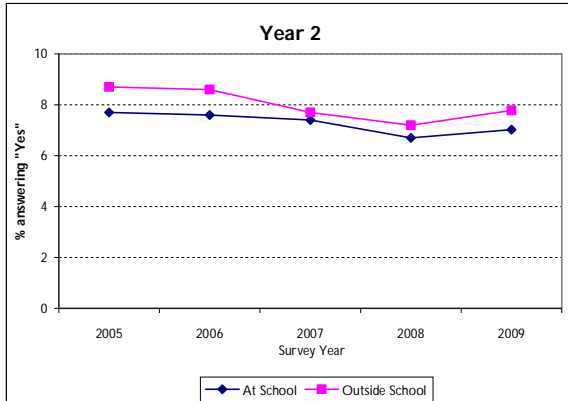
