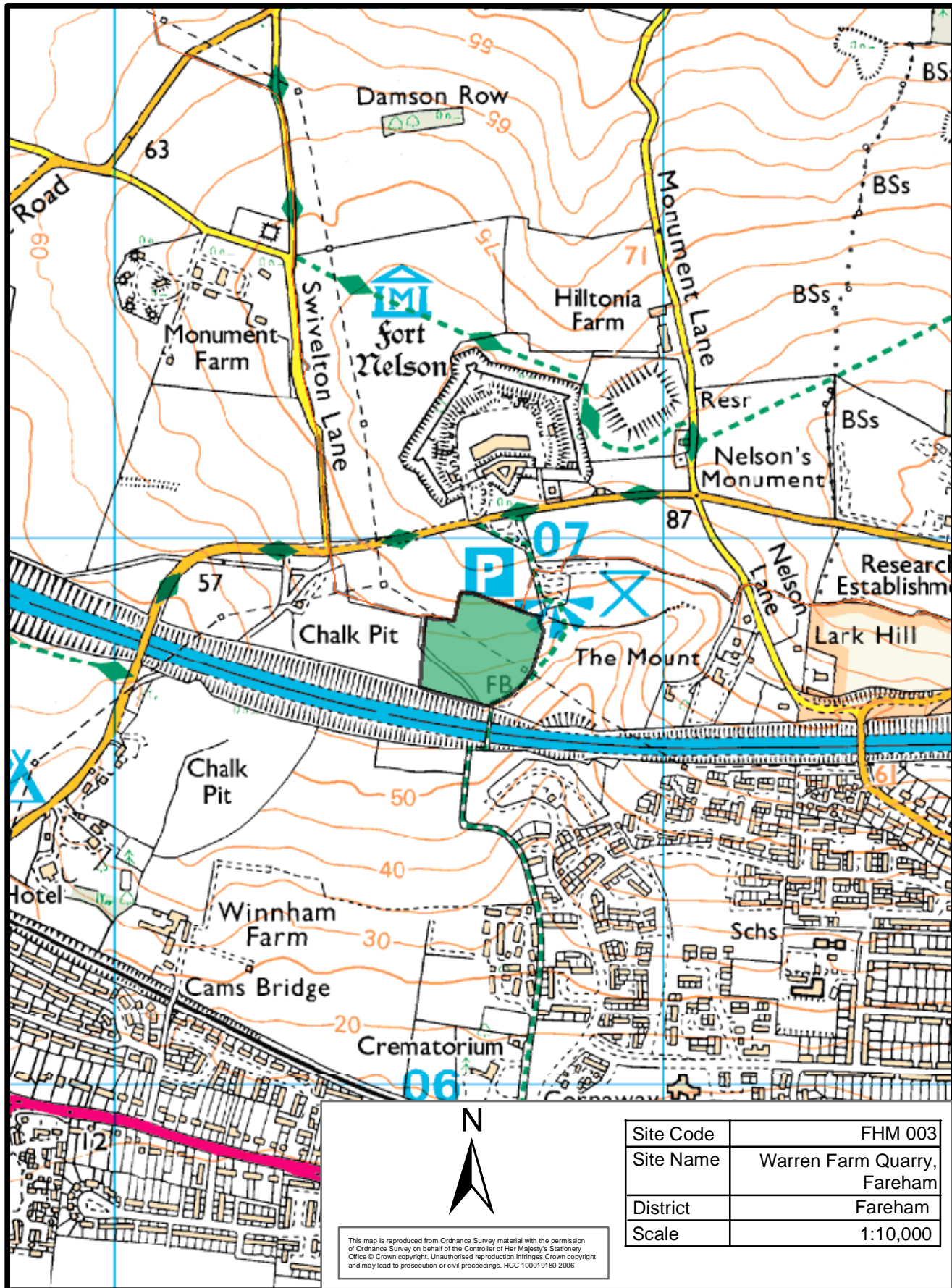


FHM 003 : Warren Farm Quarry, Fareham

Site Area	3.3 ha
Proposed Use	Extraction of chalk, amount not known at this stage. The site has no potential for non-hazardous landfill restoration due to the presence of an aquifer. There is potential for inert landfill restoration.
Site Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ The site is located on Portsdown Hill, but it would be worked as an extension of an adjacent chalk quarry and would be unobtrusive.➤ The site is immediately south of Fort Nelson, a Scheduled Ancient Monument and therefore, an opinion from English Heritage is required as to whether this site is in the setting of the Monument.➤ The site has a high archaeological potential.➤ The site overlies a major aquifer.➤ There are residential properties within 250m of the site.
