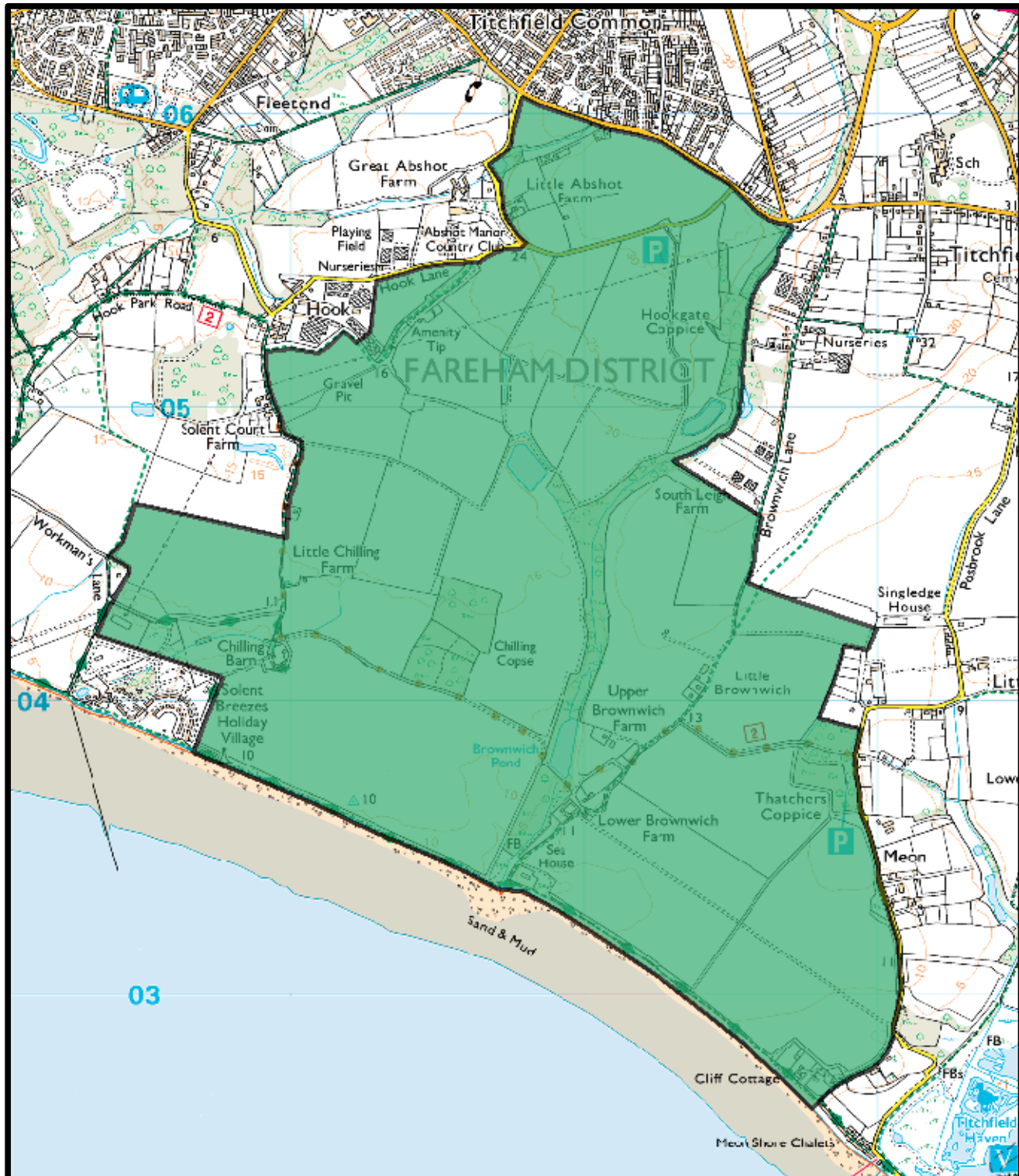


FHM 004 : Brownwich and Chilling Estate, Fareham

Proposed Use	<p>Extraction of chalk and gravel, volume not known at this stage.</p> <p>The site has some potential for restoration by landfill, but further assessment is required.</p>
Site Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ The site is a huge area of coastal plain and there is potential for working some of the less sensitive areas.➤ The site lies adjacent to a Special Protection Area, Site of Special Scientific Interest and a RAMSAR site.➤ The site has a high archaeological potential.➤ The site contains several important groups of listed buildings.➤ A tidal river runs through the site and there is some flood risk on part of the site.➤ There are residential properties within and around the site, but the site is large enough to accommodate appropriate mitigation including buffers.➤ Part of the site is within an Airport Safety Exclusion Zone.➤ Three footpaths cross the site and there is a public car park on the site.
