Mouth watering and inspiring days out are guaranteed for you and your group among the culinary delights of Hampshire. From tempting chocolate and delicious preserves to superb cheeses, fine wines and flavoursome beers, Hampshire's food and drink trail is not to be missed. Why not get 'hands on' with delicious chocolate at **Le Salon du Chocolat** near Havant, where you can mould your own novelties and take them home to enjoy. Learn the art of traditional jam making at **The Real Jam and Chutney Co.** in Winchester, sampling delights such as blackberry and apple jam, elderberry jelly and spiced carrot chutney.

Beer making is a fascinating process and Hampshire offers a variety of demonstrations with plenty of opportunities for sampling. The family-run **Oakleaf Brewing Company** in Gosport makes champion cask and bottled beers with their own distinct flavours, so whether you like your beer clean and crisp, fruity and floral or dark and malty there's bound to be a taste to suit you. **Ringwood Brewery** in the New Forest is Hampshire's leading independent family brewer and here you can combine a brewery tour with delicious tastings and a hearty ploughman's supper. For beer making on a larger scale visit **Coors Brewers**, near Alton, or if wine is more your tittle head for **Wickham Vineyard** in Shedfield to try some of its fine products and learn about wine making on this picturesque site.

Life on the farm is appealing and at **Dairy Barn Farm** near Stockbridge the rare breed sheep, cattle and pigs are reared traditionally and fed naturally on the herb-rich pastures of the Test Valley. You can learn how to care for the animals on livestock courses or buy tasty meats, organic vegetables, cakes, ice creams and cheeses from the well-stocked shop. For a cute and cuddly experience visit **Longdown Activity Farm** in the New Forest, where you can feed calves and kid goats and meet the piglets, ducks, rabbits, chicks and alpacas. When you get hungry a tasty cheese supper awaits you at **Lyburn Farmhouse Cheesemakers** in the north of the New Forest. The family has been farming on this site for 34 years and will tell you all about traditional cheesemaking techniques.

**Winchester City Mill** is on a site used for milling since Saxon times and is one of several historic mills in Hampshire. You can find out about our flour making heritage and try hand milling at this pretty riverside location while at **Eling Tide Mill** on the edge of Southampton Water you can watch Britain's only fully working tide mill in action. **Bursledon Windmill** near Southampton still produces stoneground flour used by Hampshire bakeries and in contrast to Eling's wave power harnesses the natural energy of the wind. **Whitchurch Silk Mill** also provides a fascinating insight into the history and manufacture of silk and produces fine materials and costumes for theatrical productions, historic houses and interior designs. For a memorable lunch or cream tea come on board the famous **Watercress Line** from Alresford to Alton and enjoy a steam powered trip through ten miles of beautiful Hampshire countryside.

For all your touring needs and some delicious and delightful days out, be sure to visit Hampshire.





## 7 Longdown Activity Farm

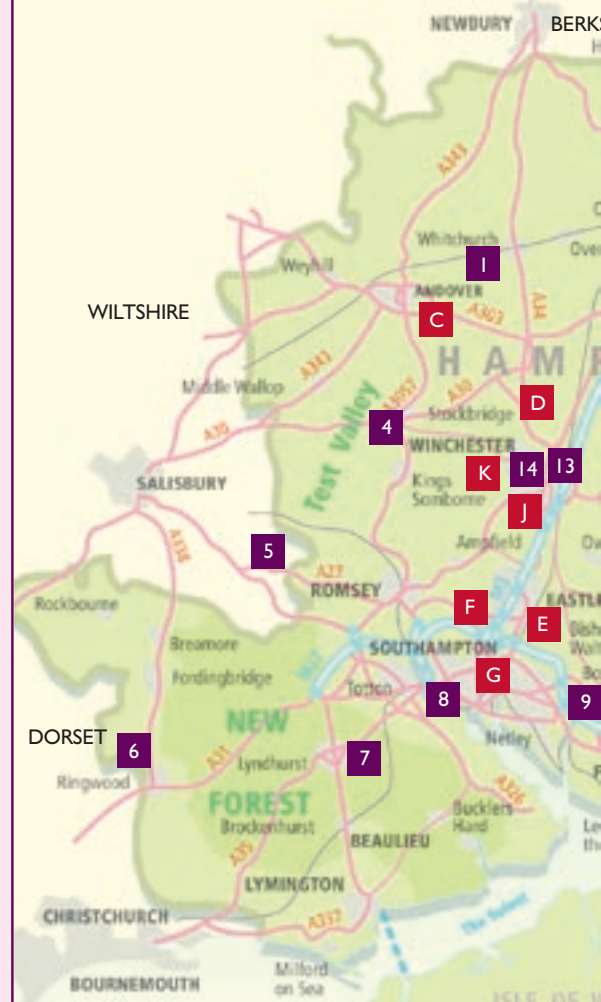




## 8 Eling Tide Mill



