



Proposed new Primary School at Whiteley

Notice is given that The Portsmouth and Winchester Diocesan Board of Education, Peninsular House, Wharf Road, Portsmouth PO2 2HB intends to establish a new Voluntary Aided Primary School under section 11(1A) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006.

It is proposed that the school will open on 1 September 2013.

The school will be situated within Whiteley and serve the existing development at Whiteley.

The school will be a community school with a Church of England religious character and it is confirmed that the proposer intends to ask the Secretary of State to designate the school as a school with such a religious character.

The new school will cater for pupils between the ages of 4 and 11 and provide places for 210 boys and girls. The admission number for the school on the opening date will be 30.

Pupils will be admitted to the school in accordance with the governing body's admissions policy, published each year before the date on which applications must be submitted; this includes details of the criteria to be applied in the event of over-subscription.

Transport will be provided for any pupils who qualify under the local authority's published policy.

All applicable statutory requirements to consult in relation to these proposals have been complied with.
