#### 1. The decision:

- a) That the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services approves the Children's Services Integrated (CSI) grant applications of £5,000 and above for 2013/14, totalling £814,512 for organisations within Hampshire as listed in Appendix 3.
- b) That the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services approves the Youth Support Services grant awards for 2013/14 totalling £1,728,765 for organisations within Hampshire as listed in Appendix 5.
- c) The Executive Lead Member for Children's Services approves the SfYC grant awards of £5,000 and over for 2012/13 totalling £12,388 for organisations within Hampshire as indicated in Appendix 6.

#### 2. Reason(s) for the decision:

2.1. These decisions support the following Hampshire County Council priorities;

“Making Hampshire safer and secure for all” – by supporting organisations that provide positive activities for children and young people.

“Maximising well-being” – by supporting organisations that deliver services to children and young people, or aim to help vulnerable children and young people.

2.2. They also support the outcomes of the Hampshire Children and Young People Plan (CYPP), the Local Children's Partnership priorities and all the five outcomes of Every Child Matters.

2.3. The YSS decisions will support the provision of local projects and services which have been steered by the Local Children's Partnerships in line with the government's commitment to the 'Big Society'. These services retain a focus on young people who are the most vulnerable enabling them to access targeted services in their local area.

2.4 The SfYC decisions are in line with the Children's Services commitment to working in partnership with the voluntary sector and the commitment by the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services to reinvest additional contract savings into the children's centre programme.
