

## ***Information For Parents***

***You may find these notes useful in your communication with parents, in addition to specific details concerning your school's programme.***

The accommodation is in centrally heated dormitories equipped with showers and drying rooms. There are laboratory, classroom and recreational facilities. However, the main purpose is for the pupils to study the environment, and they will spend a large part of their time out of doors. Suitable clothing and footwear are therefore essential. The following list may be helpful:-

- Trainers and wellington boots
- Extra socks and underclothing for the week
- Anorak or warm coat
- Gloves, hat, extra sweaters etc. in colder parts of the year
- Sun hats and sun cream in warmer parts of year
- Pyjamas or nightdress, slippers and dressing gown
- Toilet requisites, in a bag
- Named shower cap for girls
- Two distinctive towels
- Games clothes

Anoraks and wellingtons are available at the Centre for those children who require them. Binoculars, cameras, torches and compasses are worth bringing, but children will be expected to care for their own property. **No other valuables should be brought** e.g. no mobile phones, personal stereos or Gameboys.

**PLEASE NAME ALL ARTICLES** as far as possible, and provide a kit list to help with packing at the end of the week.

There is a tuck shop. Pocket money is looked after by the staff. It is suggested that a maximum of £15 pocket money will be sufficient. Additional souvenirs may be purchased using the **Souvenir Order Form** enclosed with this booklet.
