

**Tender for provision of an  
Integrated Offender Management (IOM) Service  
(Hampshire County Council area)**

Hampshire County Council's Wellbeing & Partnerships (on behalf of the County Strategy Group for Community Safety) invites expressions of interest from suitably experienced providers who wish to be considered for selection to tender for the provision of an Integrated Offender Management (IOM) specialist service, to those aged 18yrs and over. *(NB: Including working with Youth Offending Team in managing transition of young offenders into adult IOM services)*

The Hampshire IOM service aims to reduce crime and reduce reoffending through commissioning specialist interventions primarily consisting of, but not limited to:

- Criminal Justice Integrated Teams (CJIT) covering both drugs and alcohol clients (includes those covered under DIP priorities)
- Provision of Alcohol Brief Interventions and harm reduction support
- Provision of community based interventions to Prolific and Priority Offenders (PPO)
- Assertive outreach and engagement on these client groups

Hampshire County Council is looking to commission a single provider for provision of these elements across the Hampshire County Council area *(not unitary areas of Southampton, Portsmouth, Isle of Wight)*.

This is intended as an innovative approach to challenging offending behaviour and working towards reintegration, through providing the right interventions to the right individuals at the right time. This new service will require a high level of partnership working, including working with other co-located criminal justice staff, including Probation, Police and Youth Offending Teams. The new combined service will be responsible for the joint engagement, case and care management (where appropriate), referrals and reintegration of their designated criminal justice clients.

The contract will initially be for a period of three years with the option to extend for a period or periods not exceeding two years (subject to satisfactory performance and continuation of grants from central government).
