Background

- LAA agreed in June 08
- Period April 2008 – March 2011
- Targets against 33 indicators agreed with Government covering joint priorities
- 16 statutory targets
- 13 targets against local indicators
- Sustainable Community Strategy

Opportunities

- Focus on collective priorities and improved outcomes for communities
- Stronger communication with the public on the joint ambitions of partners
- Stronger voice in the region
- More effective partnership working and delivery
- Fewer burdens – accountable for outcomes
- Cross border working (eg MAAs)

Challenges

- Understanding and reflecting priorities for all Hampshire communities
- Staying focused on these priorities
- Comprehensive Area Assessment
- Over focus on *targets*
- Full buy-in at all levels
- Co-ordination of activity and partnerships
- Joining up eg to tackle inequalities
