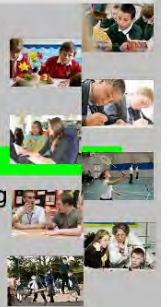

- consult young people with disabilities, parents, carers and professionals on revised eligibility criteria
- facilitate Youth Council elections
- evaluate Personal Development and Learning (PDL) with East Hampshire Education Improvement Partnership.
