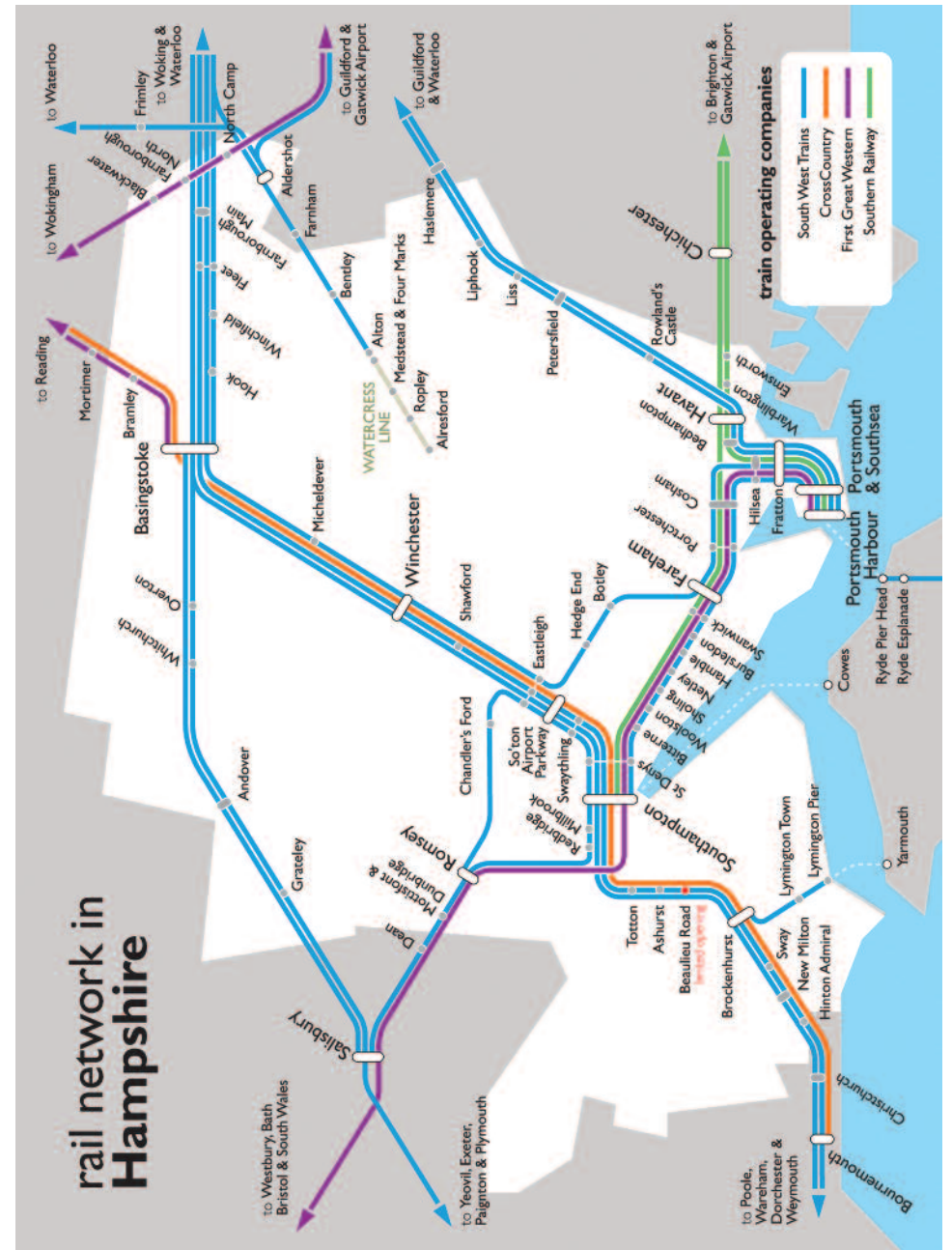
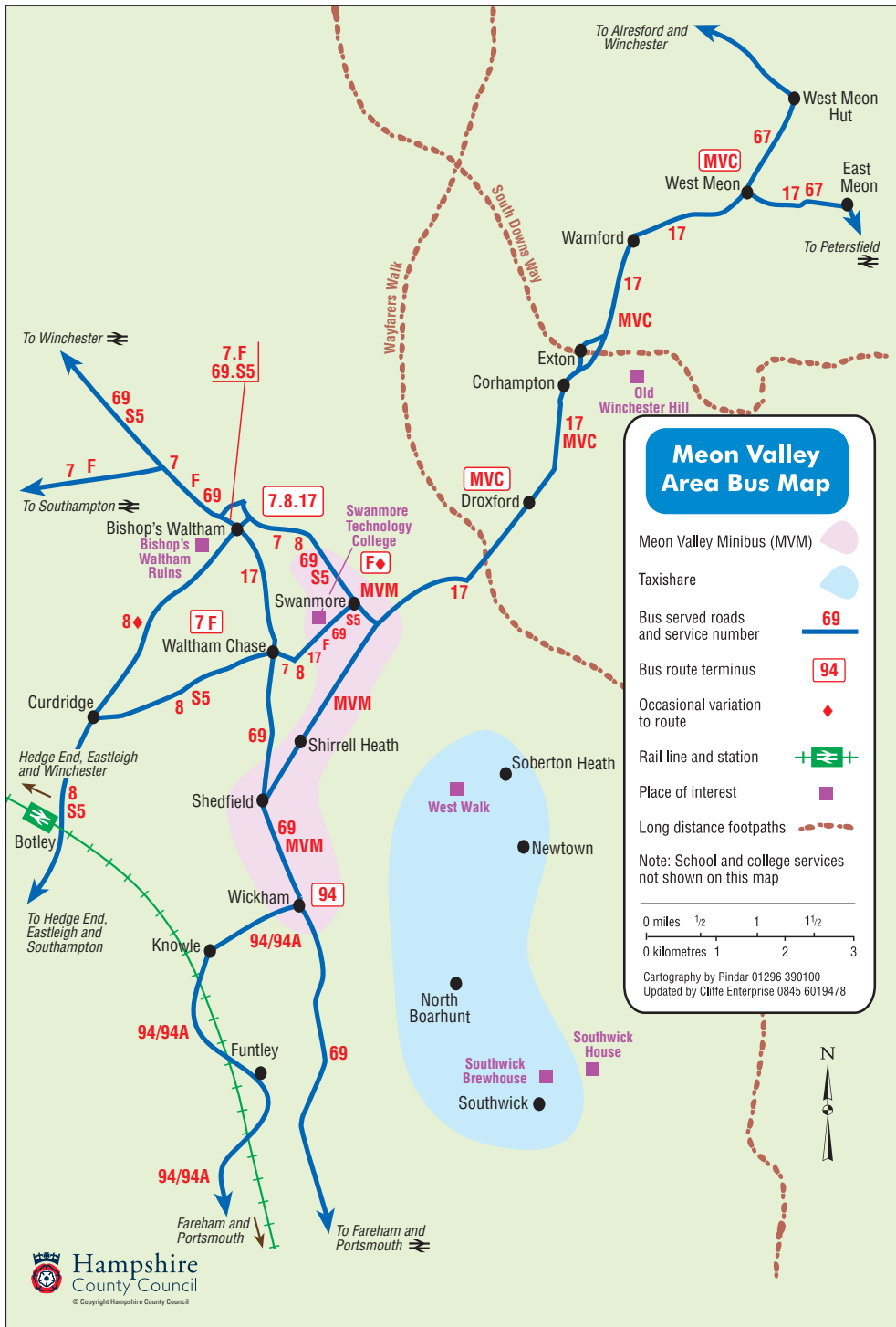

Introduction

October 2011 Edition

This Travel Guide has been produced to provide you with information on the range of transport choices available in your area. It includes details of all bus, train, coach and other types of transport.

Please note that bus times may change at short notice and if your journey time is critical you are advised to call Traveline on 0871 200 22 33.

How to Find the Bus you Need

The contents page and maps will show you which routes serve the places you wish to travel to. Many services have different timetables for weekends and evenings, check carefully for the time you wish to travel.

Catching the Bus

Please arrive at the bus stop with a few minutes to spare and signal clearly by raising your arm when your bus approaches. Have a selection of change or your pass ready when you board and hold on tight until you are in your seat. Ask the driver if you wish to be seated before the bus moves off. When you wish to get off, ring the bell in good time.

Public or Bank Holidays

Most bus or train operators run Sunday or special services on Public or Bank Holidays, including other days around Christmas and New Year. Check with the bus/train operator before you go or call Traveline.

General Enquiries

Traveline can provide you with details of journey times. For ticket and fare information contact the operator who runs the service.


Timetable Changes

Bus companies can change their services at short notice. This Travel Guide is up to date at the time of going to print, but changes may occur from the publication date. If in doubt please check with Traveline.

Dial a Ride provides door to door transport for anyone who finds it difficult or impossible to use ordinary bus services. You do not have to be registered disabled or a wheelchair user to use Dial a Ride. For example you may have difficulty climbing steps onto buses, or be unable to walk to the bus stop.

You will need to register to use the service and phone to book your journey. Bookings are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

The minibus will collect you from your door at the arranged time and take you to your destination. The well-trained and friendly drivers will help you in and out of the minibus. Dial a Ride minibuses are specially adapted with handrails and low steps to help passengers. Each vehicle is equipped with a lift or ramp to assist wheelchair and walking frame users.
