A warm welcome awaits you and your group in Hampshire, where our award-winning attractions tell the exciting story of the country's naval, aviation and military history. From magnificent ships to mighty fortresses, from gun battles to air power, Hampshire has it all. Our quality sites, excellent facilities and easy accessibility make Hampshire the top destination for military heritage in the south.

Hampshire has played a leading role in the defence of the realm for centuries, from Nelson's victory at the Battle of Trafalgar to the D-Day landings in the Second World War. Home to both the British Army and the Royal Navy, the county has also witnessed some of the most important developments in aviation, such as the building of R.J. Mitchell's famous Spitfire in Southampton and Samuel Cody's first powered flights near Farnborough.

From submarines, helicopters and tanks to cannons, missiles and warships, Hampshire's historic sites and museums provide a dramatic insight into our military heritage as well as telling the moving stories of the many people involved with it.

At **Portsmouth's Historic Dockyard**, marvel at the breathtaking sight of Henry VIII's favourite warship, the Mary Rose, recovered from the ocean floor 450 years after she sank in the Solent, and of the Tudor longbows, games, coins and utensils used by her crew. On board the magnificent HMS Victory, see the spot where Hardy kissed the dying Nelson, or move on to HMS Warrior and imagine what life was like for a 19th century sailor. If you dare, take command of a warship or fly a helicopter into battle at Action Stations!, Portsmouth's exciting naval museum, which features interactive naval exercises.

At Gosport's award-winning **Explosion! museum** you can learn about the thousands of female munitions workers who produced the nation's armaments in WW2. And for more big bangs visit the **Royal Armouries at Fort Nelson**, where the underground tunnels, big cannons and spectacular views over the Solent show you what it was like to train firepower on the enemy. For a relaxing trip visit **Portchester Castle**, with its beautiful coastal views and the most complete Roman ramparts in northern Europe. At **Buckler's Hard** in the New Forest, you can learn how this picturesque site on the banks of the Beaulieu River was used to build over 50 wooden ships for the Royal Navy in the 1700s.

And don't forget **Winchester's Military Museums**, where you can find out about the brave men who mounted the Charge of the Light Brigade or trace the proud history of six regiments.

For lovers of the sky, there's **Solent Sky** and the **Museum of Army Flying** at Middle Wallop, where the sight of Tiger Moths, Spitfires, gliders and other aircraft exhibits is bound to evoke memories. **The Royal Navy Submarine Museum** at Gosport also explores life under the sea while **Aldershot's Military Museum** provides an interesting insight into the history of the British Army.

There's much more to discover about our military past, so for enjoyable and fascinating excursions and all your touring needs, visit Hampshire, where a friendly and professional welcome is assured.
