Is the development listed in Schedule 1? **No**

Is the development listed in Schedule 2? **11 other projects(b) installations for the disposal of waste.**

Is the development likely to have significant effects on the environment?

The site is about 100 metres from controlled water (Tickleford Gully) but not in a sensitive area, and the site area (0.273 ha) is below the 0.5 threshold. Site handles about 55,000 tonnes of household collected waste a year. Site is in restored landfill site. Development not likely to have significant effects on the environment as visually contained, all waste handled within the waste transfer building and site engineered to contain any potential pollution to water environment

The proposed development is not an EIA development under the *Town & Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) (England & Wales) Regulations 1999* as although within Schedule 2 is not within a sensitive area, below the 0.5 ha threshold and is not likely to have significant environmental effects.
