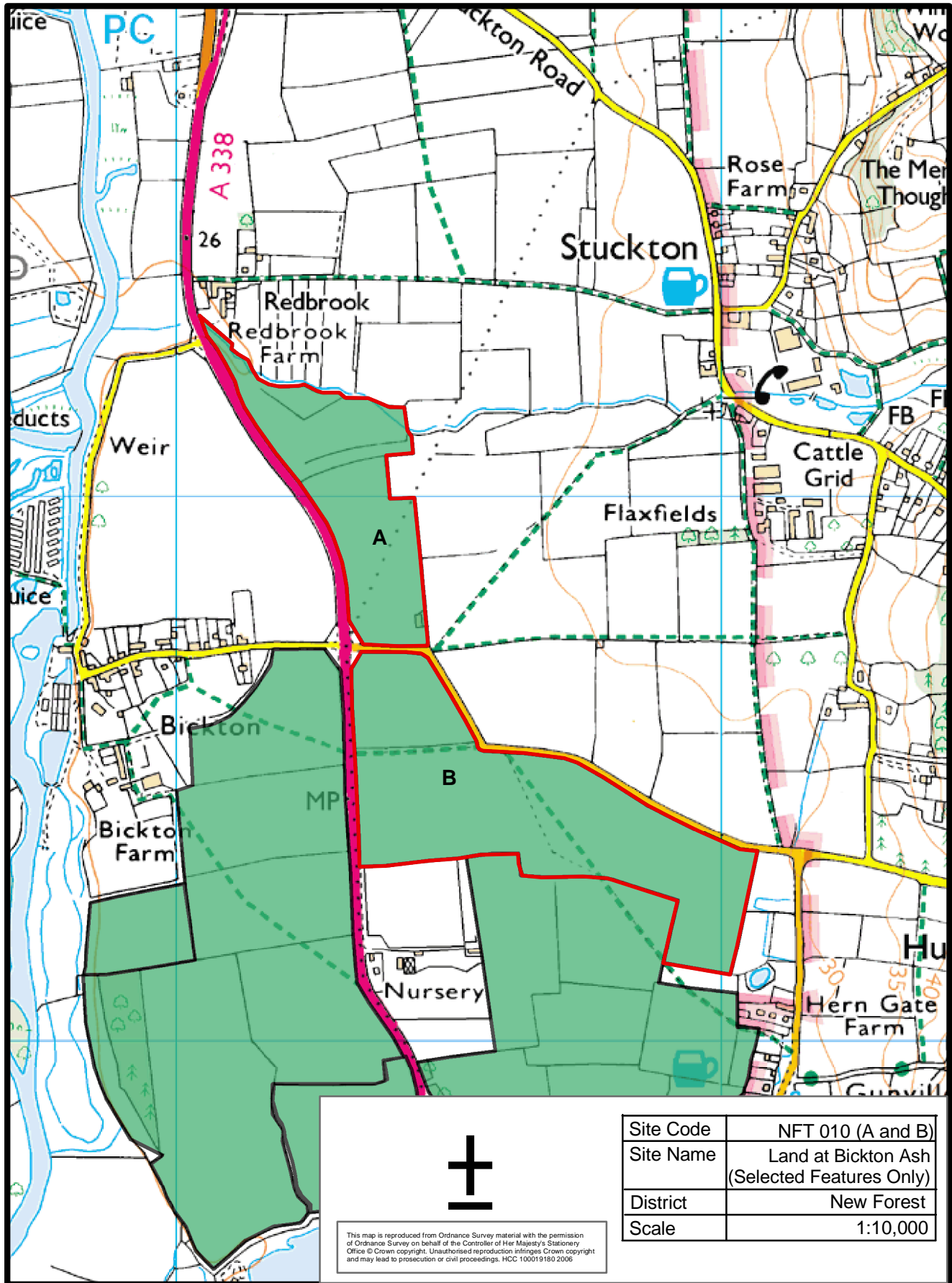


NFT 010 : Land at Bickton Ash (A and B)

Site Area	(A) 9.05 ha (B) 18.0 ha
Proposed Use	<p>Extraction of approximately 1 million tonnes of sand and gravel.</p> <p>Up to 400,000 cubic metres of landfill void space will be created.</p> <p>The sites have potential for inert landfill restoration. The river valley location rules out non-hazardous landfill.</p>
Site Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ The site is within 1 km of the boundary of the New Forest National Park.➤ The site is set in a farmland landscape and the site is relatively exposed making mitigation more difficult.➤ The site lies within 100m of a Site of Special Scientific Interest, 200m of a Special Area of Conservation and 250m of a Special Area of Conservation/Special Protection Area.➤ The site has some archaeological potential as there is indication of Roman occupation on the site.➤ The site is adjacent to a Conservation Area and listed buildings.➤ There is potential for flooding on the northern edge of the site.➤ There are residential properties adjacent to the site and Bickton Village is within 250m.
