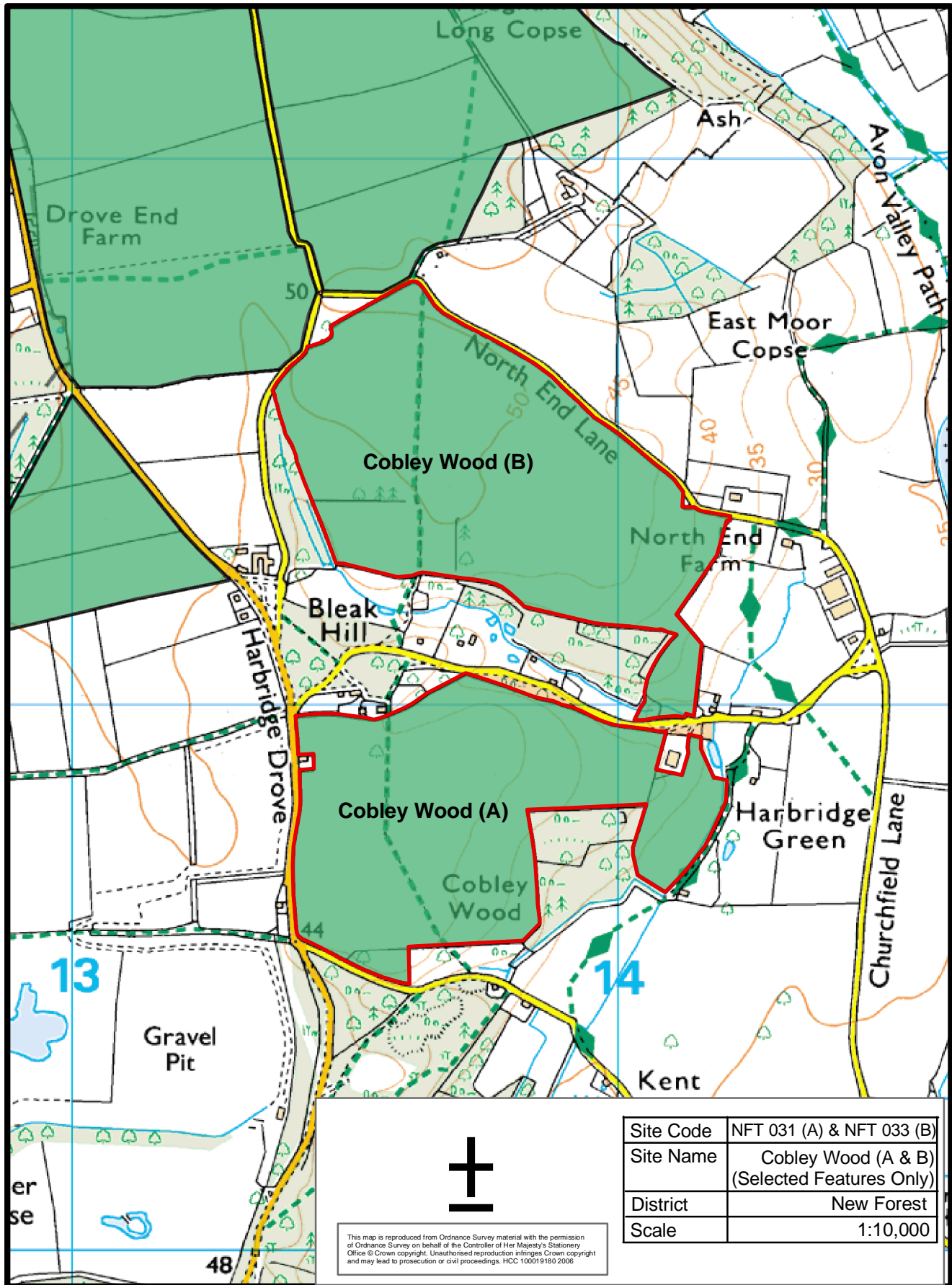


## NFT 031 & 033 : Cobley Wood (A and B)

<b>Site Area</b>	(A) 26.6 ha (B) 32.1 ha
<b>Proposed Use</b>	<p>Extraction of 2 million tonnes of sand and gravel, restoration by landfill (combined).</p> <p>Up to 250,000 cubic metres of landfill void space will be created (combined).</p> <p>The sites have potential for non-hazardous landfill restoration and inert landfill restoration.</p>
<b>Site Issues (A and B)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ The site is on an elevated edge of a terraced landform that is significantly sensitive. The terrace falls steeply into the Avon Valley allowing long distance views into the site.</li><li>➤ The site lies adjacent to a Site of Importance for Nature Conservation and is surrounded by woodland.</li><li>➤ There residential properties adjacent to site A and within 250m of site B.</li><li>➤ Site B has archaeological potential.</li><li>➤ The site is within an Airport Safety Exclusion Zone.</li><li>➤ A footpath crosses both the sites.</li></ul>
