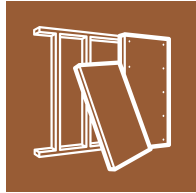


Acceptance of Plasterboard at HWRCs

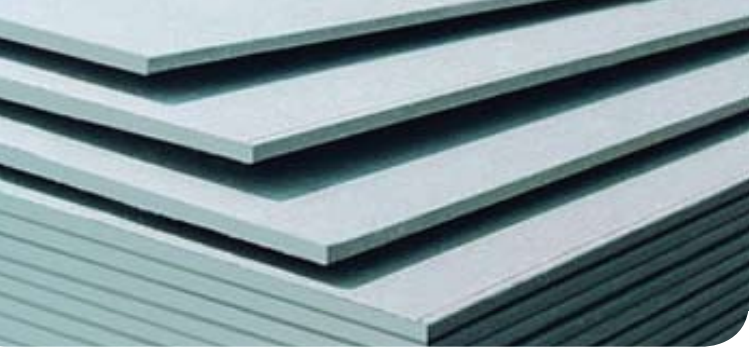
Regulations introduced in April 2009 mean that plasterboard must be separated from other types of waste at Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs) to ensure that it is disposed of properly.



All HWRCs have a dedicated storage container for plasterboard. On arrival at the site, please seek assistance from site staff who will be able to direct you.

As with other DIY waste, plasterboard is not classified as household waste. Hampshire County Council does however recognise that households may produce small quantities, and so will accept **small incidental off cuts arising from minor DIY projects only.**
