

Using the large keyboard and tracker ball

Every Library has at least one terminal with extra facilities designed for people with special needs. These include voice output via headphones, text magnification, a large print keyboard, and a tracker ball to use instead of the mouse. If you would like any of these facilities, please check which terminal you need to book.

In some libraries you may find that the specially equipped terminal is already set up with the large keyboard and tracker ball installed. In that case you can start your session immediately.

In other cases you may find that the large keyboard and tracker ball need to be connected up to the terminal in place of the standard keyboard and mouse. If this is the case, please see a member of staff who will be pleased to change these items over for you.

If you would like to use the headphones, please ask for those at the counter.

If you would like to use the screen magnification and / or voice output facilities, go to the instructions on using the Supernova and Lunar software (Section 11 of the User Guide).
