Conditions of Hire

1. The organiser will be responsible for the control of the BBQ.
2. It is recommended that the organiser ensures that a mobile telephone is available in case of emergency.
3. No other fires may be lit in the Park.
4. Please ensure that the BBQ is doused or burnt out before leaving the site. Cold ash (doused) should be disposed of in the bins provided.
5. The organiser is responsible for cleaning the BBQ grill.
6. All daytime BBQ's must finish by 5pm and evening BBQ's by 11pm.
7. Camping is not permitted and there should be no overnight stays after the BBQ.
8. When music is part of the entertainment, organisers must ensure that it is maintained at a reasonable level and does not inconvenience the residents of the Park. If this condition is breached, the organiser may be asked to terminate the BBQ and no refund will be given. **Amplified music is not permitted.**
9. Organisers must conform to any instruction given by the park staff.
10. Group organisers must indemnify Hampshire County Council against any claims arising from this booking.
11. Hampshire County Council does not accept any loss or damage (other than death or personal injury resulting from the negligence of the County Council, its servants or agents).
12. Bouncy castles are not permitted.
13. Please read government guidelines on food safety www.food.gov.uk and Barbeque safety www.fireservice.co.uk.

Important Notes

1. All vehicles must use the seafront road to get to the BBQ sites (see map).
2. Vehicles for evening BBQ's must be on site by 9pm. The Park is then closed to incoming traffic. Vehicles may leave freely after this time using the one-way barrier.
3. It is suggested that coaches drop off customers by the Park centre (Empire Rooms) and collect them from the main entrance.
4. Water is available from taps at various points in the BBQ field.
