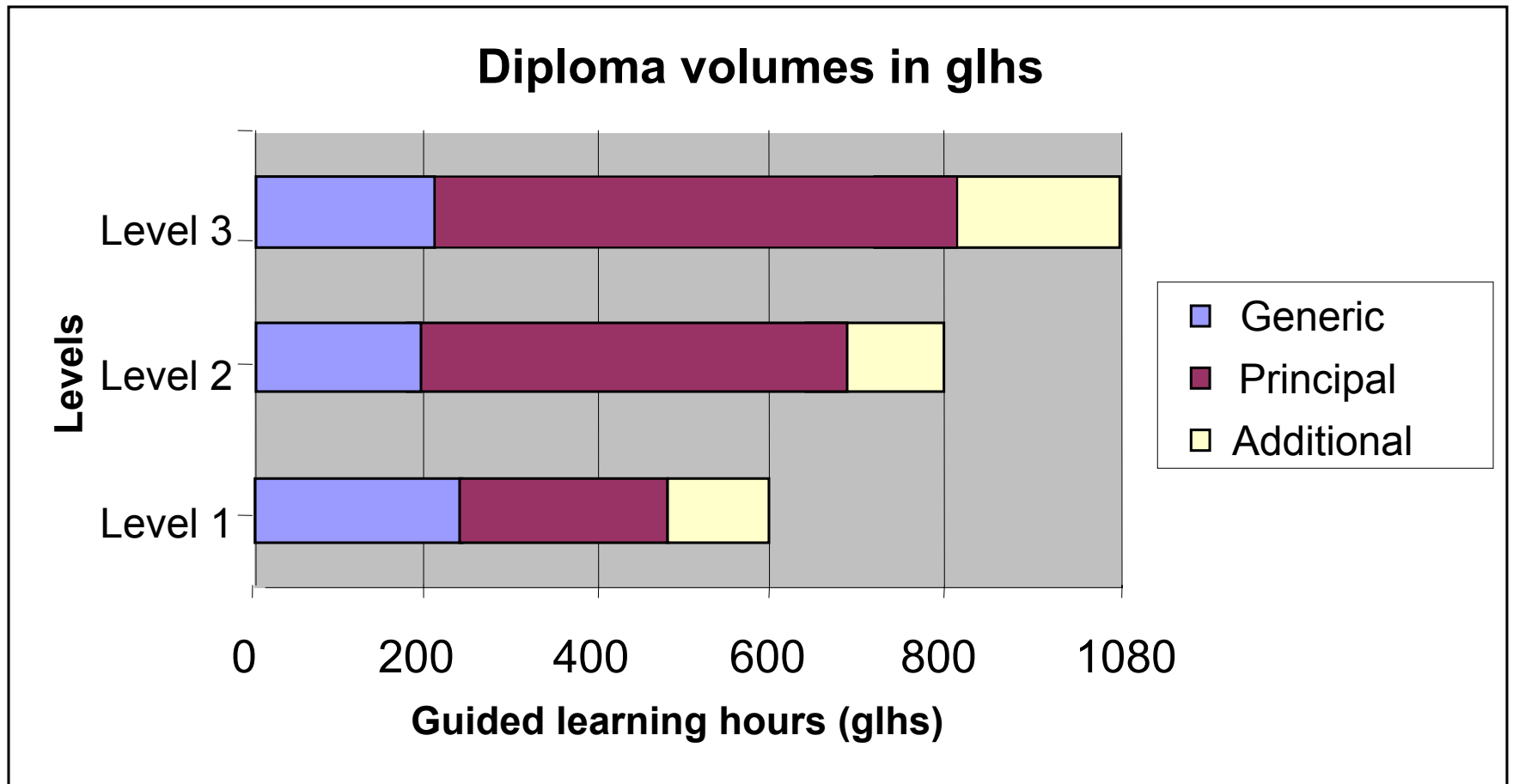
# The New Specialised Diplomas

- **2010** - Public Services, Sport & Leisure, Retail and Travel & Tourism

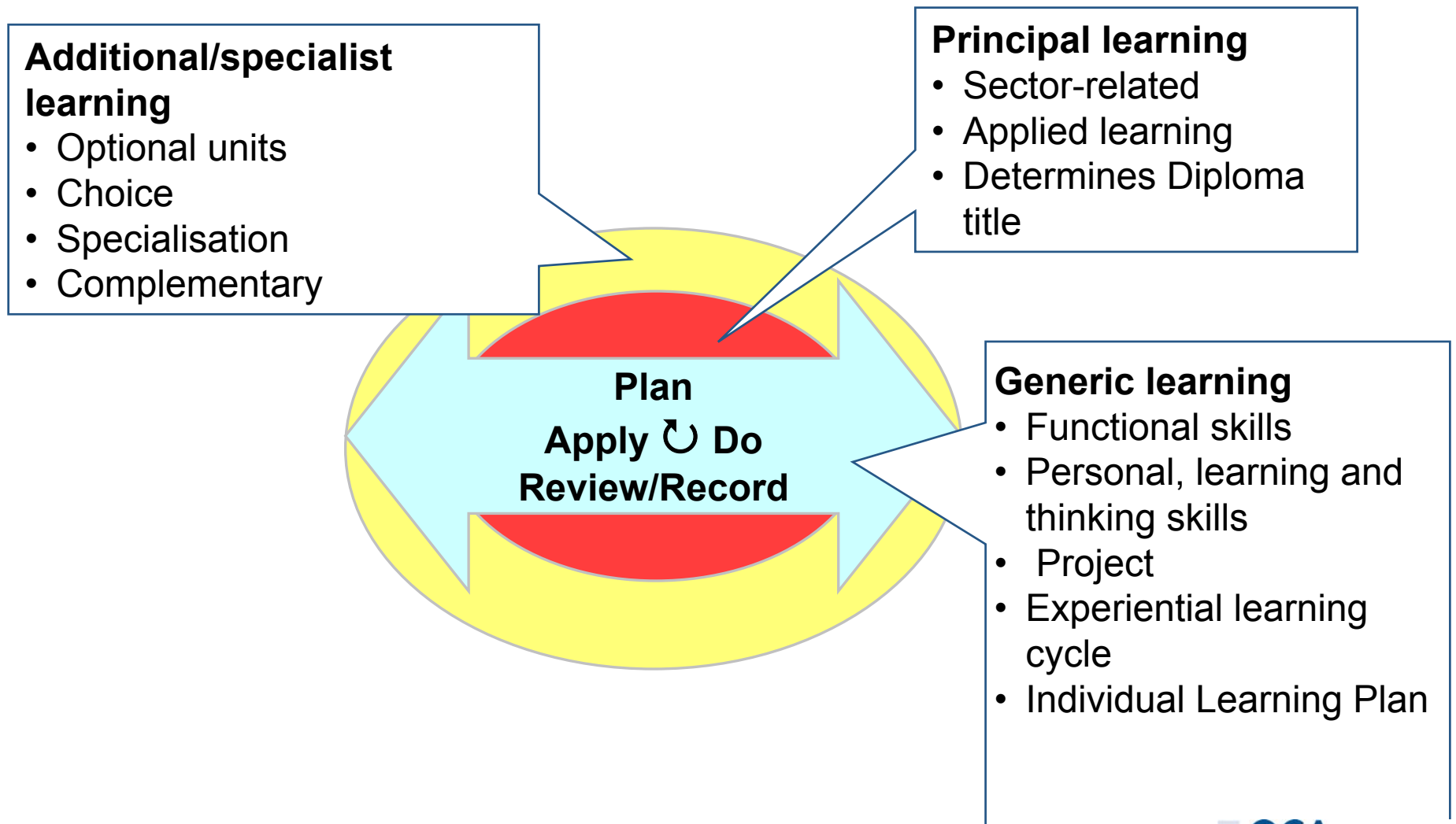
# The Future for 14+

- Pathways for all – 40% by 2013
- Increase in Level 1 and 2 + FS 16-19
- Economic well-being and a positive contribution strands of ECM
- Engagement and the prevention of NEETs
- Wider than just mainstream schooling
- Judged in consortia not just home school
- Agreed offer in a given travel to learn area
- Quality and gap filling issues in a TLA

# GCSEs will change

- **In 2006**
  - new science GCSEs and two-tier maths
  - consultation on place of coursework in maths
  - new titles available (GCSE history and business studies)
- **In 2009**
  - GCSEs in English and ICT to include functional skills
  - most other GCSEs revised following coursework review
- **In 2010**
  - GCSE maths to include functional skills
  - further maths qualifications available, including possibility of double award

# Travel-to-learn

- 9 new 14-19 consortia over 10/11 districts
- Equal partnership of all
- MLE/VLE ILPs and PDL and ‘personalised’
- Barriers – real and perceived
- The area prospectus – autumn 2007
- The sDiploma Gateway end Nov
- Aligned with 14-19 Progress Checks

# Funding 14-19

- Increased Flexibility last cohort
- Dedicated School Grant for Practical Learning opportunities pooled
- Alignment of funding streams
- LA use of retained funding and capital support
- LA and LSC funding to support 14-19 reform - LID
- More future funding
