Introduction

This booklet summarises the wide range of services, advice and provision available for children with statements of special educational needs (SEN) in Hampshire.

Hampshire maintains a continuum of provision for children with SEN. One of the key principles of Hampshire County Council's special educational needs policy is that children should receive an appropriate education in mainstream schools. In Hampshire the majority of children with special educational needs attend local mainstream schools where they receive the support they need. The Local Authority must ensure that a child with a statement of special educational needs is educated in a mainstream school except where that is incompatible with the efficient education of other children at the school.

We also recognise, however, that special schools and specialist resourced provisions in mainstream schools play important roles in the overall spectrum of provision for children with SEN and if a parent/carer indicates that they do not want their child educated in a mainstream school then the Local Authority will consider options for placement in local maintained specialist provision. Details of the specialist provision maintained by Hampshire County Council are given in this booklet.

Within Hampshire County Council the Children's Services Department offers support to individual children, including those with SEN, and to their parents/carers. We aim to work closely with families, schools and other agencies to give all children access to high quality learning opportunities by providing a range of services including the Special Educational Needs Service, the Educational Psychology Service, the Services for Young Children, the Youth Support Service and the Specialist Teacher Advisory Service.

School staff will be able to discuss any queries you may have about the school and your child's education. There is also a number of professionals to help you and your child including:

- educational psychologists, who offer practical help and guidance to children with physical, emotional, behavioural or learning difficulties, their parents/carers and the staff who work with them
- specialist teacher advisers, who provide a range of services including advice and support to children, parents/carers and schools to help children with physical disabilities and visual and hearing impairments.

Provision

Mainstream schools

Mainstream schools have a statutory responsibility to meet the needs of children with SEN. Every mainstream school has a designated SEN governor and a Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator (SENCo) to help them fulfil these responsibilities. The key responsibilities of the SENCo include:

- overseeing the day to day operation of the school's SEN policy
- liaising with and advising other teachers
- managing other SEN staff and learning support assistants
- co-ordinating provision for pupils with SEN
- liaising with the parents of pupils with SEN
- contributing to the in-service training of staff
- liaising with external agencies such as the Local Authority's support services, health and social care services and voluntary bodies.

The majority of children with special educational needs will have their needs met in mainstream schools, without the need for a statement of special educational needs, under the School Action and School Action Plus stages of the SEN Code of Practice (2001). They will be provided with an Individual Education Plan (IEP) which sets out short-term targets for the child and describes the support which will be provided, by both the school and home, to help achieve them. The IEP will be updated on a regular basis.

Children with more complex needs may be subject to a statutory assessment possibly leading to a statement of special educational needs. Mainstream schools must put in place the provision detailed in the statement and must, at least once a year, make arrangements for an annual review of the statement. This provides an opportunity for parents/carers, the child, the school, the Local Authority and other professionals involved to consider the progress the child has made over the previous 12 months and whether any changes or amendments need to be made to the statement.

There are 498 mainstream schools in Hampshire (427 primary, infant and junior schools and 71 secondary schools). Details of these schools are on pages 27 to 41. Children living near to the Hampshire boundary might attend a school in a neighbouring authority, eg Portsmouth, Southampton, Dorset. Please refer to guidance provided in *A Parent's guide to applying for a school place in Hampshire* for further details (www.hants.gov.uk/ad-information).

Mainstream specialist resourced provision

Some mainstream schools have attached specialist resourced provisions which make inclusive provision for children whose level of need is more severe. Hampshire currently has 56 resourced provisions (5 in children's centres, 32 in primary schools and 19 in secondary schools). Details of these schools and a web link to further information for each school are given on pages 4 to 10.

Specialist resourced provisions cater for children with a specific category of SEN, eg hearing impairment; physical difficulties; autistic spectrum disorders, etc and allow children to access a mainstream curriculum in a supportive environment where there are staff who have relevant specialist expertise and knowledge.

The child will normally spend most of his or her time in mainstream classes with friends and peers but will also spend some time in the resourced provision base in order to access the additional specialist help and support available there.

Special schools

Special schools are “schools specially organised to make special educational needs provision for pupils with special educational needs” (*Department for Education and Skills, 2001*). In Hampshire there are 26 special schools to provide places for children with statements whose level of special educational need is more severe and complex. Some of these schools also provide for pre-school children with very significant needs. Hampshire special schools provide for a wide range of special educational need, with eight catering for the primary age range, ten the secondary age range and seven the 2-19 year age range. Details of these schools and a web link to further information for each school are given on pages 12 to 15.

Some special schools focus provision on specific categories of SEN, eg severe learning difficulties (SLD) or behavioural, emotional and social difficulties (BESD), whilst others work with a broader range of need. For example, all moderate learning difficulty (MLD) schools include provision for children on the autistic spectrum. Some of those schools making provision for children aged between 2-19 are designated as learning difficulty (LD) schools, reflecting both the wide range of needs of pupils attending these schools and the breadth of provision available to meet them.

Class sizes in special schools are generally smaller than those in mainstream schools, resulting in higher staff/pupil ratios. The special schools have a high level of specialist resources, including staff with specialist expertise, and provide a focus for multi-agency involvement.

Special schools offer a highly structured, modified curriculum delivered at a pace and level matched to pupils' individual needs. Each child will have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) which sets out short-term targets and the support provided to achieve them and which is designed to facilitate their individual access to the curriculum. Depending on their level of need, at secondary level children have the opportunity to gain accreditation at either Entry level or Foundation level at GCSE. Some schools also offer ASDAN and Vocational Studies courses.

At least once a year special schools must make arrangements for an annual review of each child's statement. This is a way of monitoring and evaluating the effectiveness of their provision and placement and ensuring that once a year parents/carers, the child, the school, the Local Authority and other professionals meet to discuss the child's progress and whether any changes or adjustments need to be made to the statement.

Educational Psychology Service

Teams of educational psychologists are based in our local offices and so cover every community in Hampshire. We are all registered with the Health Professions Council. We all hold post-graduate qualifications in educational psychology and most are qualified teachers. Psychology helps us understand how people think, learn, feel and develop. Our work is often concerned with developmental difficulties involving learning, social, emotional, behavioural, physical or sensory needs. We look at ways of helping children make progress when they are experiencing difficulties.

We...

- have a responsibility for working with children from birth to 19 years of age
- expect those who ask for our involvement to have first obtained the agreement of parents/carers
- are always keen to work closely with parents/carers, voluntary groups and professionals from other services
- can be contacted directly by parents/carers. Each local office has a telephone contact line that parents/carers can use. However, if a child attends a pre-school or school then it is usually helpful if a parent has first discussed their concerns with staff
- assess children with special educational needs, help set targets for learning and monitor progress
- undertake some direct therapeutic work, such as counselling pupils
- offer consultancy services and training to school staff, governors and others in the community
- offer guidance and support to teachers and pupils in special schools
- help early education settings and schools to provide individual educational programmes for children with learning and behavioural difficulties, physical and sensory impairments and language disorders
- work with early education settings and schools to develop policies in areas such as the effective management of difficult behaviour and inclusion.

Portage Service

Hampshire Portage is an educational service for pre-school children with additional support needs and their families. The Portage model supports parents to build on their child's successes and to use small steps to help their child achieve new skills.

Portage home visitors are experienced early years practitioners who have experience in understanding, recognising and developing the individual needs of the child. The service supports children with significant developmental delay and behavioural difficulties.

Hampshire Portage Service works in partnership with parents, carers and other professionals such as therapists, health visitors, paediatric consultants, educational psychologists and early years settings. This helps to ensure that everyone works towards shared common goals.

The family receive regular home visits during which activities are planned to enable the child to learn through play and having fun. Support often extends to the early years setting the child attends. Outreach support is also available for those children at Early Years Action Plus who do not meet the criteria for the core service.

Portage can also be involved to ensure a successful transition to pre-school or school depending on their age.

Youth Support Service

The Youth Support Service provides information, advice, guidance and support to all young people aged 13-19. We also work with young people with learning difficulties and/or disabilities, up to the age of 25, to help them make the best possible transition into Adult Services.

The Youth Support Service has specific responsibilities for young people with learning difficulties and/or disabilities. These include:

- attending the Year 9 Annual Review of the statement of SEN and transition planning
- overseeing the implementation of the resulting Transition Plan
- assessing education and training needs on leaving school and with the support of other professionals already working with your child, describing the provision required to meet their needs in further/higher education or training (known as the 'Moving on Plan' or S139A Assessment)
- reviewing the Moving on Plan in further education or training
- supporting your child if they apply for funding for special educational provision and services (for example, residential courses for young people over 16), in partnership with other agencies
- supporting the smooth transition to Adult Services at 19, or later, dependent on an assessment of the needs of each young person. In Hampshire, the Youth Support Service is provided by Hampshire County Council. We employ specialist personal advisers to work with young people with complex learning difficulties and/or disabilities, and their families, including those who are educated in schools and colleges outside Hampshire.

County Admissions Team

The County Admissions Team deals with all applications from Hampshire residents for school places in the County's maintained mainstream schools, except those for children with statements of special educational needs. Applications for children designated at School Action or School Action Plus but without a statement are dealt with by the Admissions Team, even where the process of statutory assessment is underway.

The County's admission arrangements, including its admission policy, are consulted on and determined each year in accordance with statutory requirements, well in advance of the school year to which they relate. Each school has an admission policy: community and controlled schools follow the County's policy; voluntary aided and foundation schools and academies determine their own admission arrangements and policies. Where a school is oversubscribed, the school's admission policy is used to prioritise applications.

The deadline for applications for transfer to secondary school in September 2012 is 31 October 2011. The outcome of these applications will be notified to parents either by email (if they applied online) or by first class post on 1 March 2012.

The deadline for applications to start school (in Year R) in September 2012, or to transfer to Year 3 in a junior school in September 2012, is 15 January 2012. The outcome of these applications will be notified to parents on 28 April 2012.

Key to school status

Academy mainstream schools (primary and secondary) - independently managed, all ability schools set up by sponsors from business, faith or voluntary groups in partnership with the Department for Education and the local authority. Admissions are co-ordinated by Hampshire County Council.

Academy special schools - independently managed special schools set up by sponsors from business, faith or voluntary groups in partnership with the Department for Education and the local authority. Admissions are co-ordinated by Hampshire County Council.

Community schools - maintained by Hampshire County Council as the local authority.

Community special schools - for children with special educational needs, maintained by Hampshire County Council.

Federations - this term describes when two or more schools have a formal agreement to share governance arrangements and work together to raise standards.

Foundation schools - maintained by Hampshire County Council but the governors are responsible for admissions. Trust schools are included in this category.

Voluntary schools - originally set up by voluntary bodies, such as the Church of England or Roman Catholic Church, but with most of their running costs now funded by Hampshire County Council. (**Voluntary aided** schools are responsible for their own admissions. **Voluntary controlled** schools follow Hampshire County Council's admission policy.)
