

## Surviving Thornycroft cars

It is believed that up to 13 Thornycroft cars survive today. The table below lists ten cars for which data has been located.

3. According to the Thornycroft sales register, three four-inch racing cars were sold. These cars were designed to compete in the 1908 four-inch TT race on the Isle of Man. Only two of them are believed to have taken part in the race. Vehicle no. 580 was delivered to H G Pelissier. Vehicle no. 801 was delivered to G V Baxendale, but may have been driven by T Thornycroft who came fifth in the race. Vehicle no. 802 was delivered to D S Hodge who came tenth.
4. A resale delivery date of 11-11-74 is given in the Thornycroft sales register. It is assumed the car still exists.
