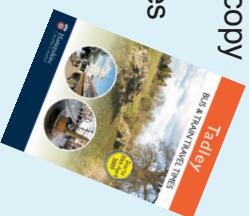

Tadley (Vitality 3)



Reading Buses

Serves Silchester & Pamber Heath
Takes 6 minutes
3 buses a day
Mon - Sat (morning)

Tadley (44) Serves Silchester, Pamber Heath & Little London
Takes 3 - 9 minutes 4 buses a day
Mon - Fri, one journey on Saturdays

Reading (Vitality 2) via Mortimer
Takes approx 30 minutes
2 buses an hour Mon - Sat
Hourly Sunday (daytime)

What is the Pamber Heath, Silchester and Mortimer West End Village Link?



This service is similar to a bus service, running at set times, only it uses a minibus to pick up pre-booked passengers from bus stops. Anyone living in Pamber Heath, Silchester and Mortimer West End can use this service. This service will only run when someone has booked a journey.

If you are unable to get to a bus stop due to a mobility issue then you can be picked up from your home. It costs the same as a bus service and passengers with a concessionary bus pass can travel for free. **You will need to register before using this service by calling Hampshire County Council on 01962 846786.** You will then be sent a membership pack with the booking number to ring when you would like to travel.

Don't forget to book when you want to travel!

Tadley (Village Link)



AMK

Serves Pamber Heath, Silchester & Mortimer West End
Takes 5 - 15 minutes
3 return trips Mon - Fri (daytime)

Passengers can also travel between destinations e.g. Pamber Heath to Silchester etc.
Don't forget to book when you want to travel!

txt4times Every bus stop in the county has a bus stop code which can be found at: www.travelinesw.info Text your stop code to **84268** to get the times of the next 3 buses. It will cost 25p, plus your normal cost to send a text.

National Concessionary Bus Pass is available to residents aged 60 or over, and residents that meet certain disability or mobility criteria.

This entitles you to free bus travel (including the Village Link service) in Basingstoke and Deane at any time of day. The bus pass can be used on the Basingstoke Dial a Ride giving a reduction in the fare.

For more information or to apply call Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council on: 01256 844844.

Outside of Basingstoke & Deane Borough the pass is restricted to off-peak use, which is 9.30am-11.00pm on Mon – Fri, all day at weekends and bank holidays.

Basingstoke Dial-a-Ride is for anyone who finds it difficult to use ordinary bus services. Picks you up and returns you to your door. Runs every Wednesday to Basingstoke. To book call 01256 462 101.

Silchester "Give and Take" provides transport to medical and hospital appointments for residents of Silchester. Call 0118 970 1055 for more information.

Burghfield & Mortimer Volunteer Bureau provides transport to anyone in need, in particular for medical appointments, available for residents in Mortimer West End and Silchester. Call 0118 983 1814 between 9.30am-11.30am for more information.

Hants Car Share Scheme allows you to get in touch with someone to share a car journey. For details visit www.hantscarshare.com or call 01962 847474.
